


## Categorymoderation

 This article is designated for administrators.

Gallery managers and moderators can approve or reject content before media is displayed. The **Categorymoderation** module is used to enable moderation for a gallery.

1. Navigate to **Categorymoderation** in the admin console under Modules / category.


