

## Is there a file size limit for uploading videos to Kaltura?

There is **no fixed limit** on the size of media files you can upload to Kaltura. You can upload large files from both desktop and mobile devices using various supported tools and APIs.

### Uploading large files

If you're building a web-based upload flow and expect users to upload large files, we recommend using the [Kaltura jQuery Chunked Uploader Library](#). This uploader splits large files into chunks, making the upload more reliable, especially over mobile networks or unstable connections.
