

How to Add Your Logo to Kaltura MediaSpace

☰ To place a logo on the Kaltura MediaSpace Header

1. Login to the Kaltura MediaSpace Admin Console.
2. On the 'Configuration Management' page, select the **Header** module.

Auth	logoImageUpload	<input type="text"/> Upload Logo Remove An uploaded image will be displayed if the logoImageUrl field (above) is blank. The image will be displayed at its native resolution. Note: the size of the logo image affects the layout of the page. Default logo size is 325px wide x 41px high. (Upload does not support IE 11 or earlier)
Categories	logoAltText	KALTURA Internal - Debbie Zioni The 'logoAltText' options are: [1] If you insert an image file in the 'logoImage' field, you may enter alternate text for the tag's 'alt' attribute; [2] If you enter 'false' or an empty string in the 'logoImage' field, you must enter text for the page header.
Channels	logoLink	home The options for defining the behavior when a user clicks the logo are: [1] Enter 'false' if you do not want the logo to be clickable; [2] Enter 'home' to display the home page (displayed when MediaSpace opens); [3] Enter a full URL (starting with http://) to open a different page in a new browser window/tab.

3. Paste your image URL in the 'logoImageUrl' field or upload your logo image in the logoImageUpload field.
4. Click Save.
5. Go to your MediaSpace site. The new logo is displayed in the MediaSpace header.
