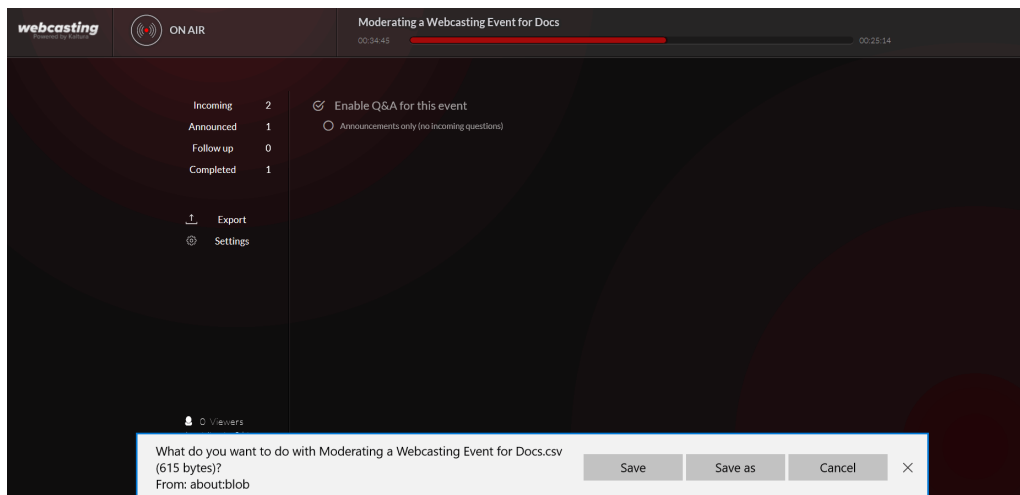

You can download the transcript from the Moderator View or Producer's Application at any time following the event.

1. Click the Q&A Navigation menu and select **Export**.



2. Select **Save** to save the file locally or Save as to modify the filename.
