

Enabling Capture in Kaltura MediaSpace and Kaltura Application Framework

This guide is intended for KMS and KAF administrators.

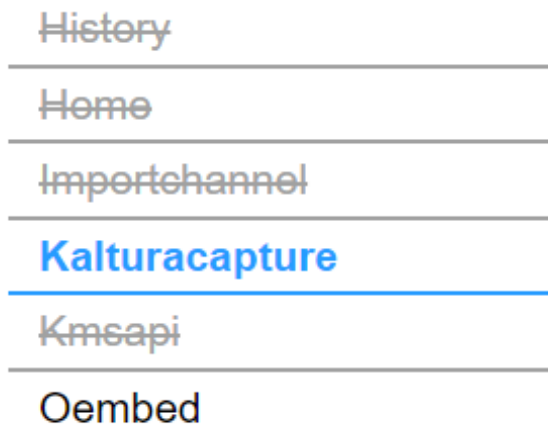
Activating Kaltura Capture in Kaltura MediaSpace (KMS) and Kaltura Application Framework (KAF)

Kaltura Capture is managed by KMS and KAF system administrators in the Admin area accessed from /admin (e.g. <https://videos.mediaspace.kaltura.com/admin>).

After your Kaltura representative has added the Kalturacapture Module to your account, configure the Kalturacapture Module as follows:

To configure the Kalturacapture Module in KMS/KAF

1. Login to Kaltura MediaSpace or the KAF Admin Console and go to the Configuration Management window.
2. Scroll down and click the Kalturacapture Module in the Modules section.

3. In the Enabled field, select Yes to enable the Kalturacapture Module.
4. Enter values for the following fields:

Field	Description
AllowDownloadingClient	Allow end users to download the Kaltura Capture dektop application from KMS/KAF.
AddNewLabel	Set the Add New menu label for Kaltura Capture.
allowedRoles	Select roles or specific users that will be able to create Kaltura Captures. If a role is selected, any role above it will also be able to create media using Kaltura Capture.
entryURL	What URL to show the user after the captured media is uploaded. Leave unchanged.

5. Click Save.

Verify that you have Activated the Kaltura Capture

To verify Kaltura Capture installation

1. Login to Kaltura MediaSpace or your KAF based application.
2. Select Add New.

Kaltura Capture, or the [chosen label name](#), should display as one of the Add New options.
