## Capture directory overview

The Kaltura Capture directory contains the following folders:

- **Bin:** Holds the KalturaCapture executables.
- **Logs:** Stores the application and UploaderService logs.
- **Recordings:** Contains local copies of your recordings.
- **Settings:** Stores the application's settings.

## How to locate the Capture directory

### Windows

1. Right click on the Kaltura Capture icon on the desktop.
2. Select **Properties**.
3. Click on 'Open File Location' and go up one folder to the 'Capture' folder.

Or simply go to: `C:\Users\<username>\AppData\Local\Kaltura\Capture\`

### Mac

1. Go to the Finder.
2. From the Go menu, select Go to Folder.
3. In the form, enter `~/Library/Preferences/Kaltura/Capture/`
4. Click Go.

Or simply go to: `/Users/<username>/Library/Preferences/Kaltura/Capture/`
