#### **About**


The Kaltura Capture directory is where you'll find all the essential files and settings for your recordings and the application itself. The directory contains the following folders:

- Bin: Holds the KalturaCapture executables.
- Logs: Stores the application and UploaderService logs.
- Recordings: Contains local copies of your recordings.
- Settings: Stores the application's settings.

## How to locate the Capture directory


#### Windows

1. Perform a search in your computer's search field, then in the **Kaltura Capture** app window, click **Open file location**.




The Kaltura Capture file displays.






2. Right click on **Kaltura Capture** and select **Open file location** from the drop-down menu.




The directory displays.

3. At the top of the directory, go up one folder by clicking Capture.



The Capture directory displays.




#### Mac

1. Click the Go menu and select Go to Folder.




2. In the form that displays, enter ~/Library/Preferences/Kaltura/Capture/, then hit **Enter** on your keyboard.
