About

Users can subscribe to channels to receive email notifications about new content and updates. Channel managers can enable the subscription option for their channels, making it easy for viewers to stay informed about the latest media added to the channel.

•

A maximum of **5,000** users can subscribe to a channel. If you expect a larger audience, we recommend using user groups to manage subscriptions more effectively.

Before you start

- Administrators must enable the Channelsubscription module and the emailnotifications module. In the emailnotifications module, you must ensure the Entry was added to channel option is checked. The email message sent through this feature is customizable.
- Channel managers must enable subscription to a channel on the channel details page. See our article Create a channel for information.

Subscribe to a channel

Theming users

- 1. Navigate to the desired channel page.
- 2. Click the bell icon to subscribe.

- 1. Navigate to the desired channel page.
- 2. Click the **Subscribe** button.

Theming users

- 1. Navigate to the desired channel page.
- 2. Click the the bell icon.

Non-Theming users

- 1. Navigate to the desired channel page.
- 2. When you hover over the Subscribe button, it changes to 'Unsubscribe'. Click it to unsubscribe from the channel.
