Kaltura Live Rooms virtual classrooms are fully brandable to highlight your organization's branding as you engage your learners through interactive tools like a digital whiteboard, screen sharing, breakout rooms, real time notes, live quizzes and a whole lot more. Kaltura meets students and users where they are by providing an optimized experience for those joining via their smartphone or tablet without the need to install another app on their device.

Kaltura MediaSpace Virtual Classroom & Webinar Module

Overview

The Kaltura Newrow Module allows you to open a real time Live Room from a Kaltura Channel or your own personal real time Live Room from the Kaltura Mediaspace or KAF Application User menu.

It is possible to select and play Kaltura media from the channel or user for synchronous playback from within the Kaltura Live Room. The real time session can be recorded and is automatically uploaded to the Kaltura Channel or My Media.

Technical Implementation

To access the Kaltura Live Room (Newrow) module, users must join from WebRTC supported browsers:

- PC Chrome, Firefox
- MacOS Chrome, Firefox
- Android Chrome.
- iOS Safari
