

How to Enable Privacy Settings for Kaltura Capture on Mac


This article describes how to enable Privacy Settings for Kaltura Capture on Mac OS.

A Please make sure to first validate the hardware and software requirements for Kaltura Capture. See Kaltura Capture - Prerequisites and System Requirements.

Symptoms

One of the following screen errors might display when attempting to start/stop your Kaltura Capture recording.

- "Failed to start recording. Please try again."
- "Failed to stop recording. Please try again."
- "Failed to load secondary device. Please restart the application."
- "Failed to load audio device. Please restart the application."



Cause


 Kaltura Capture application is not allowed to record the content of your screen/camera/audio.

Solution

Enable the Privacy Setting on Mac OS using the following steps:


- **■** To enable Mac screen recording permissions
- 1. Close Kaltura Capture.
- 2. Go to 'System Preferences'.
- 3. Click on 'Security & Privacy'.





4. Go to 'Screen Recording' and check the box next to 'KalturaCapture' .





- 5. Restart the application after changes are done to take effect.
 - **■** To enable Mac camera permissions
- 1. Select 'System Preferences' from the Apple menu.
- 2. Click the icon labeled 'Security & Privacy'.
- 3. Click the 'Privacy' tab at the top.
- 4. In the left-hand column, click on 'Camera' to manage app permissions.
- 5. Tick the box next to 'Kaltura Capture' app to grant access to the camera.
- 6. Restart the application after changes are done to take effect.
 - **■** To enable Mac microphone permissions
- 1. Select 'System Preferences' from the Apple menu.



- 2. Click the icon labeled 'Security & Privacy'.
- 3. Click the 'Privacy' tab at the top.
- 4. In the left-hand column, click on 'Microphone' to manage app permissions.
- 5. Tick the box next to 'Kaltura Capture' app to grant access to the microphone.
- 6. Restart the application after changes are done to take effect.
