The following table lists the capacities and limitations for Kaltura Meetings and Classrooms.

Standard	Virtual Classrooms and meeting	All participants are live and can publish their audio/video streams concurrently	Up to 50 Larger rooms must use "Dynamic MAX Live"	All live only supported up to 50 participants
Large	Large rooms with limited number of speakers/presenters	Up to 10 or use "Dynamic MAX Live"	Up to 300	No Quiz
XL Room	Extra Large audience with limited number of presenters	6-10 depending on preset capacity	300-700	No Quiz No Breakout



Dynamic MAX Live is a feature that allows users to un-limit the capacity of their session without worrying about number of live participants. In case the room capacity grows above supported number, the number of live participants will automatically be reduced and the longest muted participants mic/cameras will automatically be disabled. This mode can only be enabled from Kaltura's backend per room or per company. Please contact your Kaltura representative for
