Use the following instructions to enable the Wochit module.

1. Login to the Configuration Management section of Kaltura MediaSpace (KMS) at:

- In the enabled pull-down list, select **Yes**.
- In the editorType pull-down list, select which Wochit editor you would like to make available for your users - Timeline or Shortcut. For an overview of the two editors and use cases for each, please see [Timeline vs Shortcut Editor](#).
- In the allowedRole pull-down list, select KMS roles that are allowed to create Wochit videos.

If Specific Users/Groups is chosen, additional configuration options display.

- Click **+ Add "allowedUsers"**.
 - Click **Select Users/Groups**.
 - Begin to type the user ID or name of a user/group. Auto-fill completes the entry.
 - Click **Submit**.
 - Click **+ Add "allowedUsers"** and repeat steps to add more users/groups.
- Click **Save**. A message displays confirming your configuration for Wochit was saved.
 - Click **OK**.
