


Wochit - Organizing Media On the Timeline

This article describes how to organize your assets on the Timeline and create a "rough cut" of your video.

To add media to your Timeline


Click and drag assets from your Lightbox to your Timeline.



To edit your Timeline

After an asset is placed on the timeline, you may drag it, trim it, or change its duration.

A menu bar displays above the asset:





Icon	Name	Description
0	Edit	Add texts and post production effects to your video.
	Collage	Add assets on top of your video for cutaways, split-screen, or picture-in-picture effects.
c	Duplicate	Duplicate the assets (along with all of the post production effects that are set).
î	Delete	Remove media from the timeline.


To add music to your video

Here you can browse, listen to, and select music for your video. You can even upload your own music files.




To add transitions

By applying transitions to your entire Timeline, you can define the pace and style of your video. Later on, you can override these transitions in the context of each asset.

Click on transition style to the right of music.
