About

The **Cssupload module** lets you customize the look and feel of your legacy Video Portal by uploading your own CSS files. You can add extra styling, override default styles, or apply changes specifically to Theming pages. CSS files can be uploaded directly or linked from an external URL.

Configure

1. Go to your Configuration Management console and click on the **Cssupload** module. You can also navigate to it directly using a link:
https://{your_KMS_URL}/admin/config/tab/cssupload.

Function	upload css files to KMS
Bootstrap css	Upload an alternative bootstrap.min.css file to the one in use by KMS. Only useable for Bootstrap based themes.
Additional css	Upload an additional css file to KMS (will not load on theming pages).
Theming css	Upload an additional css file to KMS (applied to theming pages only).

enabled Enable the Cssupload module.

bootstrap

Collapse

upload a replacment bootstrap file.

url upload a replacement bootstrap file.

additional

Collapse

upload an additional css file.

url upload an additional css file.

2. Configure the following:

enabled - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

bootstrap - You can upload a replacement bootstrap css file. Click **Upload css file** to upload a file from your computer or paste in the url.

additional - Upload an extra CSS file to add your own custom styles on top of the existing ones. Click **Upload css file** to upload a file from your computer or paste in the url.

themingAdditional - Upload a custom CSS file that only applies to pages using Kaltura's [Theming](#) design system. Click **Upload css file** to upload a file from your computer or paste in the url.

3. Click **Save**.
