Use the **Downloadmedia module** to control which media versions (flavors) viewers can download from a media page.

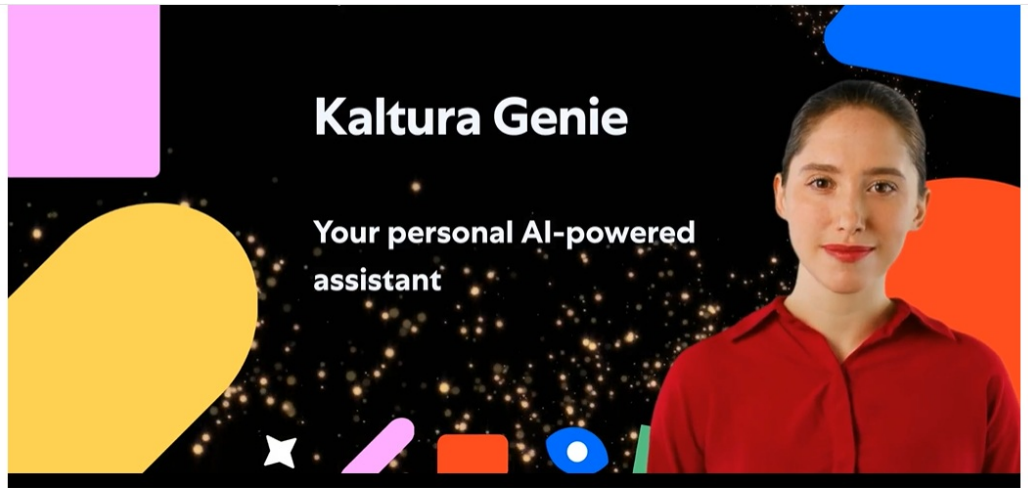
c. Click **+ Add downloadFlavors** to add more options.
