## About

The **Kalturacapture module** lets administrators control how Kaltura Capture is available in their environment.

The **Capture** option appears in the **+Create** menu when the [Theming design system](#) is enabled, and in the **Add New** menu when [Theming](#) is not enabled.

## Configure

Description	Creates Kaltura capture entries using the Kaltura Capture application.	
enabled	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes	Enable the Kalturacapture module.
AllowDownloadingClient	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes	Allow end users to download the Kaltura capture recording agent from KMS.
AddNewLabel	<input type="text" value="Kaltura Capture"/>	Select a label for the 'Add New' menu item. If left empty 'Kaltura Capture' will be used. Only relevant for the non-theming header.
allowedRoles	<input type="text" value="privateOnly Role"/>	Who can create Kaltura Capture? If a role is selected, any role above it will also be able to create Kaltura Capture.
entryURL	<input type="text"/>	What url to show the user after the captured media is uploaded. Leave blank for KMS base url.
enableBSE	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes	Enable launching Kaltura Capture from Browse, Search, and Embed module.
limitAppToken	<input type="checkbox"/> No	Select 'Yes' to limit the time of the Capture application token to 12 hours.

2. Configure the following:

**enabled** - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

**AllowDownloadingClient** - Set to 'Yes' to allow end users to download the Kaltura capture recording application.

**AddNewLabel** - Enter a custom label for the 'Add New' menu. If left empty 'Kaltura Capture' will be used.



This setting does not apply in instances where the [Theming design system](#) is enabled.

**allowedRoles** - Select the minimum role that can use Kaltura Capture. Users with this role and any higher role can access Capture.

**entryURL** - Enter a URL to redirect users after their recording is uploaded. Leave blank to redirect users to the application's base URL.

**enableBSE** - Set to 'Yes' to allow users to launch Kaltura Capture from the Browse, Search, and Embed (BSE) window.



- The enableBSE setting is available in the Configuration Management console for **KAF** and **LMS Video** environments only. It does not appear in legacy Video Portal instances.
- In KAF environments where the [Theming design system](#) is enabled, this setting does not apply.

---

**limitAppToken** - Set to 'Yes' to limit the time of the Capture application token to 12 hours.



For the `limitAppToken` setting to apply to existing users, their **appToken** must first be cleared. If you need to clear the appToken for a user, you can refer to instructions [here](#).

3. Click **Save**.
