



The **KalturaCapture module** enables administrators to configure settings for the Capture application. The **+Create** menu (as shown in the Theming design below) displays the Capture option.



## Configure

1. Go to your Configuration Management console, and click the **Kalturacapture** module. You can also navigate directly using a link: https://{your\_KMS\_URL}/admin/config/tab/Kalturacapture.

2. Configure the following:

enabled - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

**AllowDownloadingClient** - Set to 'Yes' to allow end users to download the Kaltura capture recording agent from KMS.

**AddNewLabel** - Select a label for the 'Add New' menu item. If left empty 'Kaltura Capture' will be used. Only relevant for the non-Theming header.

**allowedRoles** - Select who can use Kaltura Capture. If a role is selected, any role above it will also be able to use Kaltura Capture.

**entryURL** - Enter a url to show the user after the captured media is uploaded. Leave blank for KMS base url.

**limitAppToken** - Set to 'Yes' to limit the time of the Capture application token to 12 hours.

For the **limitAppToken** setting to apply to existing users, their appToken must first be cleared. If you need to clear the appToken for a user, you can refer to instructions here.
