About

When enabled, this module allows generating reports for My Content Analytics and user analytics for media such as quizzes.

User analytics:

- Channel / course managers can measure and analyze user engagement and contributions.
- Answer questions like: What are the most popular videos? Who watches the most and what is their drop-off rate? Who contributes the most media?
- The Userreports module and its mediaAnalytics field must be enabled to display the **Analytics** option.
- Access the **Analytics dashboard** from the 'Actions' drop-down of the media page:



num_days - default number of days
