About

When you create a channel, you can associate it to a gallery (aka a category). When users navigate to a gallery page, they will be able to browse the media and also the channels associated with that gallery. This module must be enabled to allow users to associate channels to galleries / categories and replaces the ChannelTopics module.

Configure

1. Go to your configuration management page, and navigate to the **Channelcategories** module. You can also navigate directly: https://{your_KMS_URL}/admin/config/tab/Channelcategories.

2. In the Channelcategories page, configure the following:

- **enabled** - Set to 'Yes' to enable the channelcategories module.
- **channelCategoriesProfileId** - Enter the profile id of the Channel Categories metadata profile.

Privacy:

- Open** - All logged in users can view and contribute content (contribution is not allowed for viewer-role users).
- Restricted** - All logged in users can view content and only channel members can contribute content.
- Private** - Only channel members can view and contribute content.
- Shared Repository** - Only channel members can view and contribute content; Content may be published to other channels, according to publishing entitlements.
- Public, Restricted** - Anyone can view content (including anonymous not logged-in users). Only channel members can contribute content according to their publishing entitlements.
- Public, Open** - Anyone can view content (including anonymous not logged-in users) and all logged in users can contribute content.

Options:

- Enable comments in channel
- Keep comments private to channel.
- Enable subscription to channel (link to subscribe <https://4834032.mediaspace.kaltura.com/channel/Soft+furnishing+design/303958382/subscribe>)
- Enable Newrow Live Room

 - **Private only role** - Can assign a channel to a gallery with permission.
 - **Viewer role** - Isn't authorized to assign a channel to a category.
