## About

You can enable the **channelsubscription** module so users can subscribe to channels and get email notifications for new content and updates.

Make sure to also enable the [emailnotifications module](#) and check the "Entry was added to channel" option in **Manage Notifications**.

## Configure

1. Go to your Configuration Management console, and navigate to the **Channelsubscription** module. You can also navigate directly:

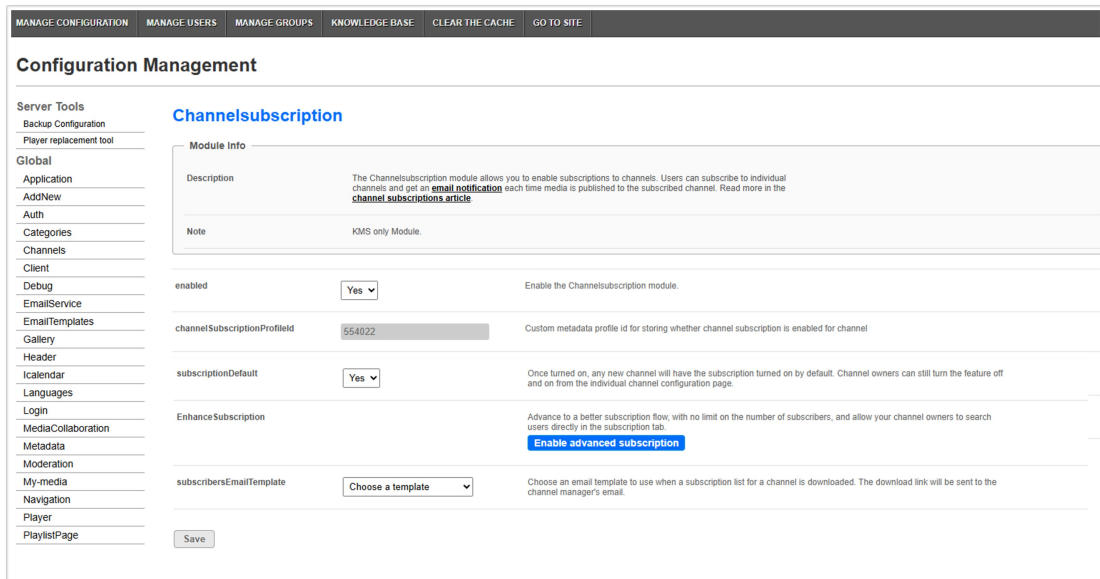

## 2. Configure the following:

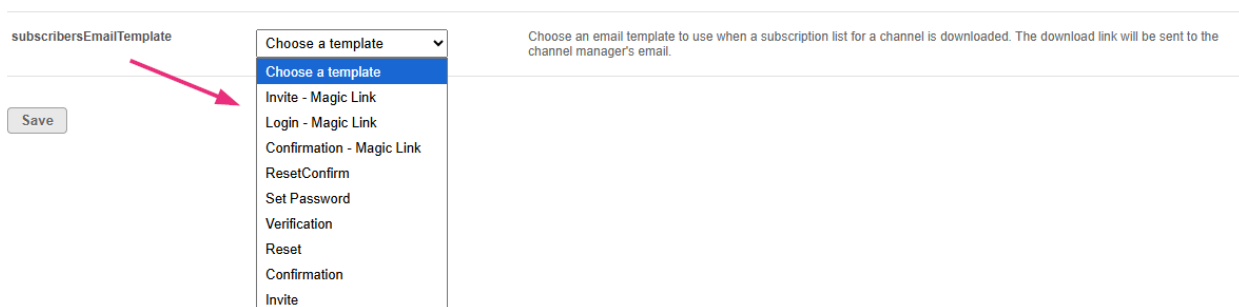
**enabled** - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

**subscriptionDefault** - Set to 'Yes' to enable subscriptions by default for new channels.

**EnhanceSubscription** - Click **Enable advanced subscription** to enable enhanced subscriptions. Once enabled:

- new channels automatically use the enhanced subscription model.
- existing channels continue to use the legacy subscription model until upgraded.
- channel owners and managers can upgrade eligible channels from the Subscribers page.
- enhanced subscriptions support larger subscriber volumes and provide subscriber search and pagination.

**subscribersEmailTemplate** - Select the email template used when subscriber lists are delivered by email.

The download link is sent to the channel manager's email address.
