instanceId	<input type="text" value="KnowledgeCenter"/>	Unique string to identify that installation of mediaspace. This value can be set during installation only.
privacyContext	<input type="text" value="MediaSpace"/>	String used to be set as privacy context on root category. This value can be set during installation only.
userRoleProfile	<input type="text" value="19233402"/>	Metadata Profile ID for user's role per KMS installation instance
virtualEventId	<input type="text" value="1078052"/>	The event ID for this site, used for analytics and prerequisite for Application Registry feature set.

**applicationRegistry**

mainSiteAlias	<input type="text" value="4834032.mediaspace.kaltura.com"/>	Set the main site domain to be used in the Application Registry and AuthBroker modules (Hostname only, no protocol. E.g. "videos.kaltura.com"). Value should be filled up automatically by Event Platform Manager (EPM).
appRegistrationID	<input type="text" value="84e2964cd104e29f69f9a1a"/>	The application registry ID. A prerequisite for Application Registry feature set (such as AuthBroker).
userProfile	<input type="text"/>	This Field indicates the use of the User Profile for registration. Application must be registered in order to use this field.

title	<input type="text" value="MediaSpace"/>	What is your MediaSpace website title? The website title is displayed in the browser's title bar and usually is displayed in search engine results. Page titles consist of the name of the currently loaded media and the website title. For example, if a page has a video called 'My Video' and 'MediaSpace' is the website title, the page title is: 'My Video - MediaSpace'
footer	<input type="text"/>	What is your MediaSpace footer text? default is: MediaSpace video portal by Kaltura

- **Clear the Cache** - Clears the system's cached data to reflect recent changes. Use this if updates (like branding or layout changes) aren't showing up on your Video Portal.
- **Go to Site** - Opens your main Video Portal so you can view and test your changes in the live environment.

You can also view your Kaltura version at the bottom of the Configuration Management console page. This is helpful when contacting Support or checking for compatibility with new features.



“KMS” and “MediaSpace” are legacy names for what is now called the legacy Video Portal.
