


InPlayer - Kaltura MediaSpace Setup for Monetizing a Specific Video

Using the InPlayer Module, content owners can monetize per title within their MediaSpace instance via both PPV and SVoD models. This article describes how to enable and configure the InPlayer module.

1. Follow instructions in Section 1 of [Kaltura MediaSpace User Manual](#) to log into KMS Admin (by going to your KMS URL and adding **/admin** at the end).
2. Login using your Kaltura user ID and password.
3. Click **Sign In**. The Configuration Management Section of KMS displays.



title	Kaltura MediaSpace	What is your MediaSpace website title? The website title is displayed in the browser's title bar and usually is displayed in search engine results. Page titles consist of the name of the currently loaded media and the website title. For example, if a page has a video called 'My Video' and 'MediaSpace' is the website title, the page title is: 'My Video - MediaSpace'
footer	MediaSpace™ <a href=http://corp	What is your MediaSpace footer text? default is: MediaSpace video portal by Kaltura
forceIECompatibilityMode	Yes	Should MediaSpace force IE to use the latest engine when Compatibility Mode is enabled? By default, if compatibility mode is enabled, Internet Explorer renders the page with IE7's engine. Turning on this option forces Internet Explorer to use the latest rendering engine. For more details, please visit this link .
theme		What is the name of your custom MediaSpace theme?
languageConfiguration	Single Language Instance	Choose your instance configuration
language	English - en	Choose the default language for a new user. In KMS when your is changing the language from the drop down list on the UI, the language will be saved on a persistent cookie. In KAF based LMS, the language on the Kaltura elements will be set according to the local language set by the user in the LMS settings.
enableLike	Yes	Enable the 'Like' feature for entries.
enableWebcam	No	This is the legacy Webcam configuration. Please use the Recorder module section to use the new Webcam capabilities.
enableEntryTitles	Yes	Include the media title in the URL of the media page when browsing the site and sharing a link to the media.
videoEmbeddability		Enable ability of published entries

4. In the list of configurable items on the left of your screen, locate and click on InPlayer. The Inplayer module will be crossed out because it is disabled by default.

5. In the enabled pull down list, select **Yes**.
 6. In the MerchantUuid field, type your InPlayer merchant UUID. To find your InPlayer merchant UUID, go to your InPlayer account at <https://dashboard.inplayer.com/account/details/details> and copy it from there.
 7. In the MonetizeContent pull down list, select the minimal role that can monetize content, or choose a specific user(s) or user group(s).
 8. In the ApiURL pull down list, select Staging or Production based on the environment you use with InPlayer (demo or live account).
 9. Click **Save**. You receive a notice that your configuration for Inplayer was saved and the cache was cleared.
