Enabling Live Broadcasting for Kaltura Classroom

Kaltura Live Broadcasting for Kaltura Classroom is managed by KMS and KAF system administrators in the Admin area accessed from <Base_URL>/admin (e.g. <https://videos.mediaspace.kaltura.com/admin>).

To enable live broadcasting for Kaltura Classroom in KMS/KAF

1. Login to KMS or KAF and go to the Kaltura Configuration Management window.
2. Scroll down and select the [Recscheduling](#) module in the ModulesCustom/core section.


