

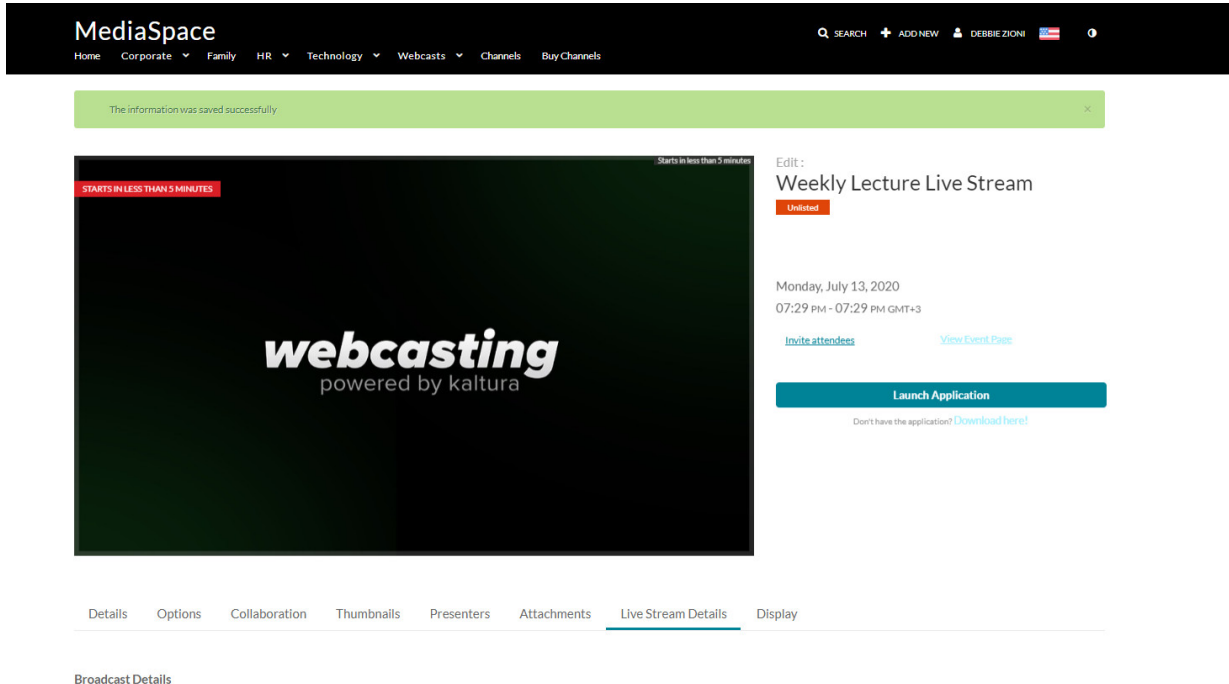

Installing the Kaltura Webcasting Software

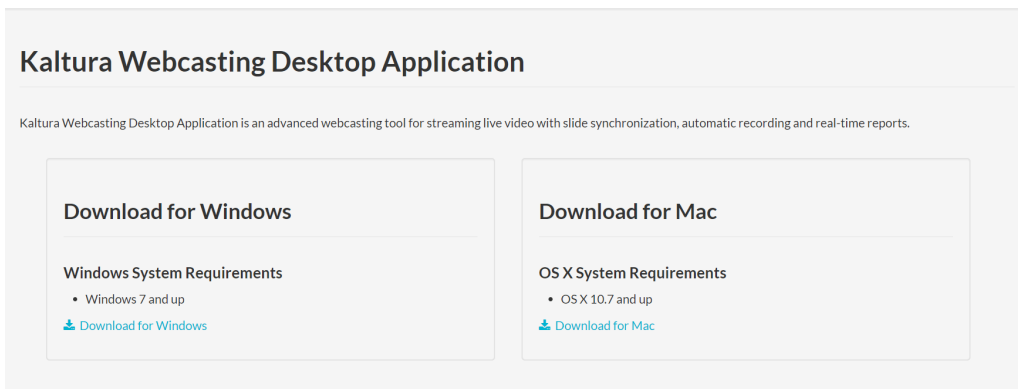
To install the Kaltura Webcasting Application

1. On the Edit Event page, click **Don't have the application? Download here.** You will be redirected to a download page.



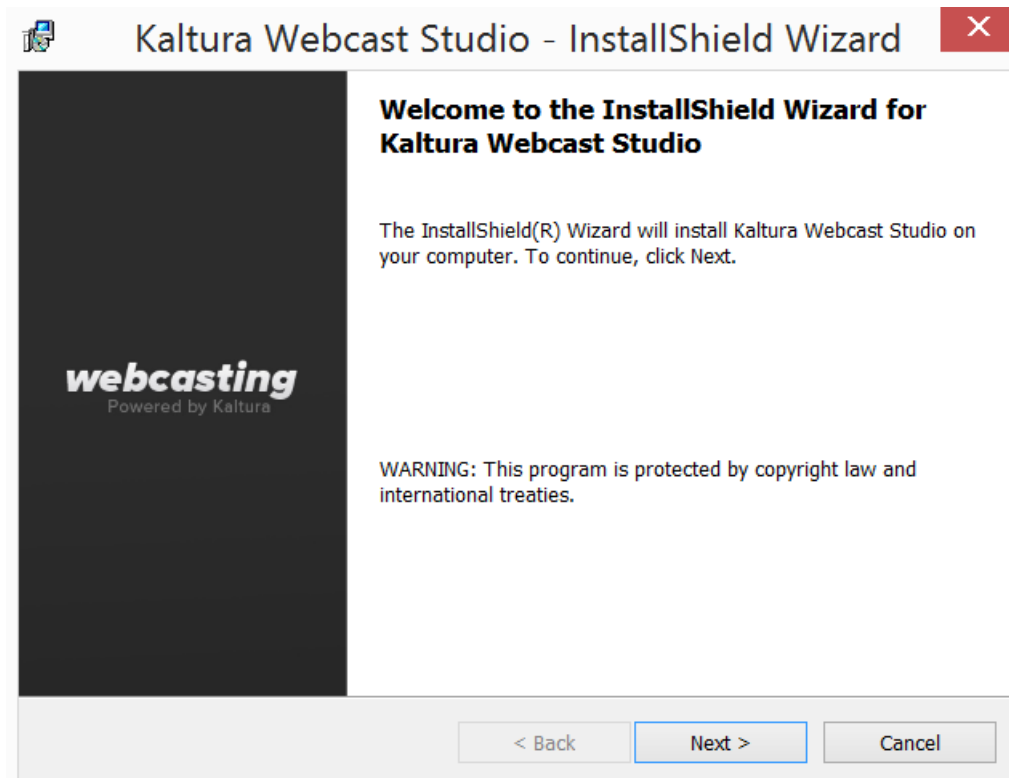

 - a. Click **Download for Windows** to start the installation.

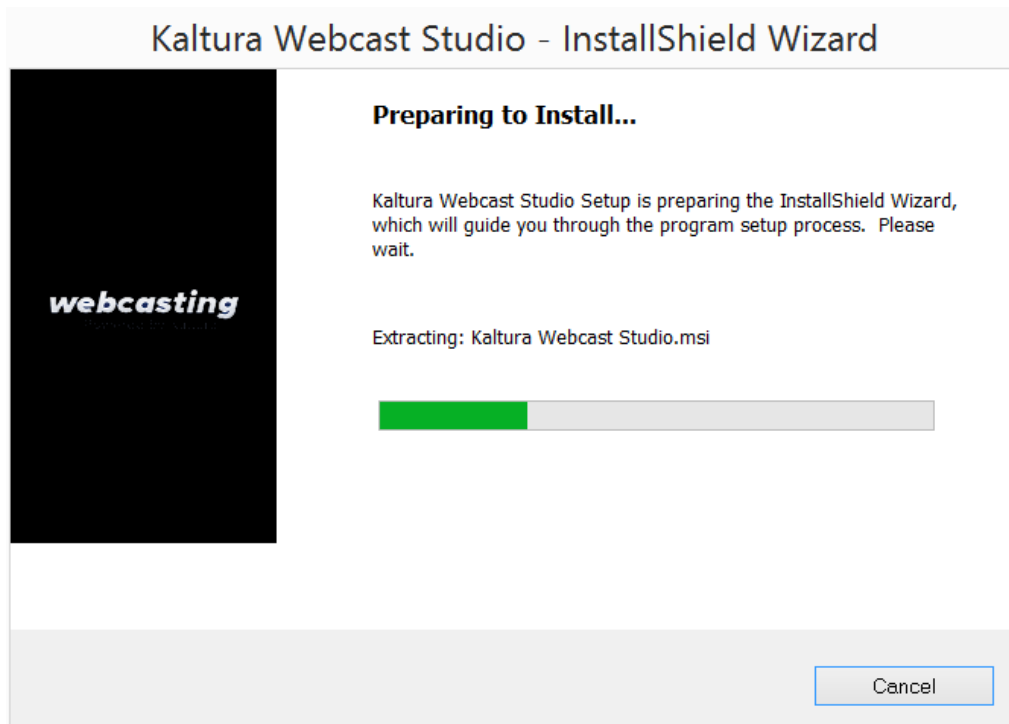

- b. The Kaltura Webcast Application installation wizard will launch. Click **Next.**



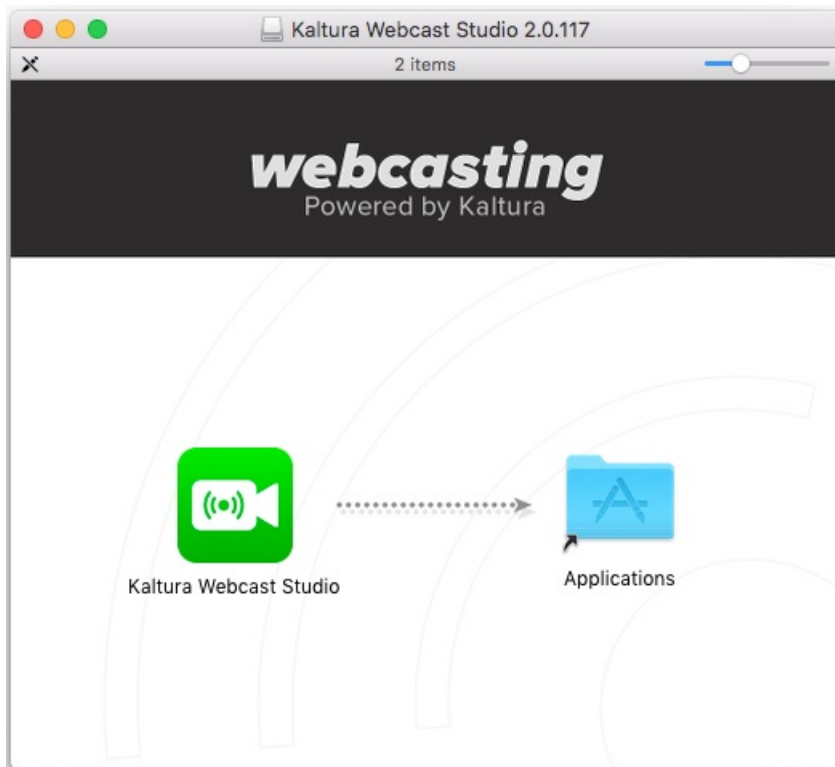
c. Complete the installation wizard and verify that the installation was successful.

 - a. Click to download the **.dmg** file.
 - b. Double click the file to open it.

- c. Drag the **Kaltura Webcast** application icon to the applications folder.



4. Return to the event page and click on **Launch the Webcast Application** button to start using the application.
