


# Streaming Zoom to a Kaltura Live Entry

This article describes how to live stream your Zoom meeting into a Kaltura Live Entry.

## ☰ To set up a live stream Zoom Meeting into a Kaltura Live entry

1. Create a Live Stream entry in the KMC by following the article: [Creating a Live Stream Entry in Kaltura Using the KMC](https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/creating-a-live-stream-entry-in-kaltura-using-the-kmc-ng) (<https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/creating-a-live-stream-entry-in-kaltura-using-the-kmc-ng>).
2. After you create your live stream entry, open that entry and navigate to the **Live Stream** tab. The information you will be pulling from this area is the **Primary URL** and the **Stream name** .

4. On the **Live stream the Zoom meeting to a Custom Service** page, set the following details:
  - a. Set the **Primary URL** under **Streaming URL**.
  - b. Set the **Stream name** under **Streaming key**.
  - c. Set the **Live Entry page URL** under **Live Streaming page URL**.
  - d. Click on **Go Live**.
