This article explains which features are supported when the source file of a video entry is removed. While video playback usually continues using existing flavor assets, some editing and transcoding features are limited.

Playback behavior

If the source file isn't available for streaming, the Kaltura Player will use the available flavor assets. Playback quality might vary depending on available flavors, but users will still be able to watch the video.
