

Submission Workflow Admin Guide for the LMS Video Assignments

 This article is designated for administrators.

About

Use embedded video submissions as assignments to prevent the video from being edited or deleted across the board for LMS integrations.

There are two ways to enable this submission workflow -

- [With the Submit as Assignment toggle button](#)
- [Using a Dedicated Submission Embed](#)

Both ways allow a user to submit media as an assignment. Upon doing so, the entry is cloned under a new user name ("OriginalUserName_assignment"). The cloned entry is unavailable in My Media, ensuring that the assignment cannot be edited or deleted.

Admin Setup

The KAF administrator can enable this feature in the [Browseandembed](#) module.

enableAssignmentSubmission	<div>Yes ▼</div> <div>No</div> <div>Yes</div>	This feature enables an additional pop up screen when selecting media in Browse, Search and Embed to verify if the user is submitting an assignment. If confirmed, the selected entry will be cloned under a different user name to prevent editing and deletion.
assignmentSubmissionText	Would you like to submit media as	Determines the text that will appear on the pop up message when submitting an assignment. In case left empty, the default message will appear.
assignmentSubmissionMaxRole	MANAGER ▼	This sets the highest role level which will see the pop up upon selecting an entry in Browse, Search and Embed.

[enableAssignmentSubmission](#) - Select **Yes** to enable a toggle button "Submit as Assignment" (previous pop-up message).

[assignmentSubmissionText](#) - Type the text that displays inside the pop-up. The default text is "Would you like to submit media as an assignment?" - DEPRECATED

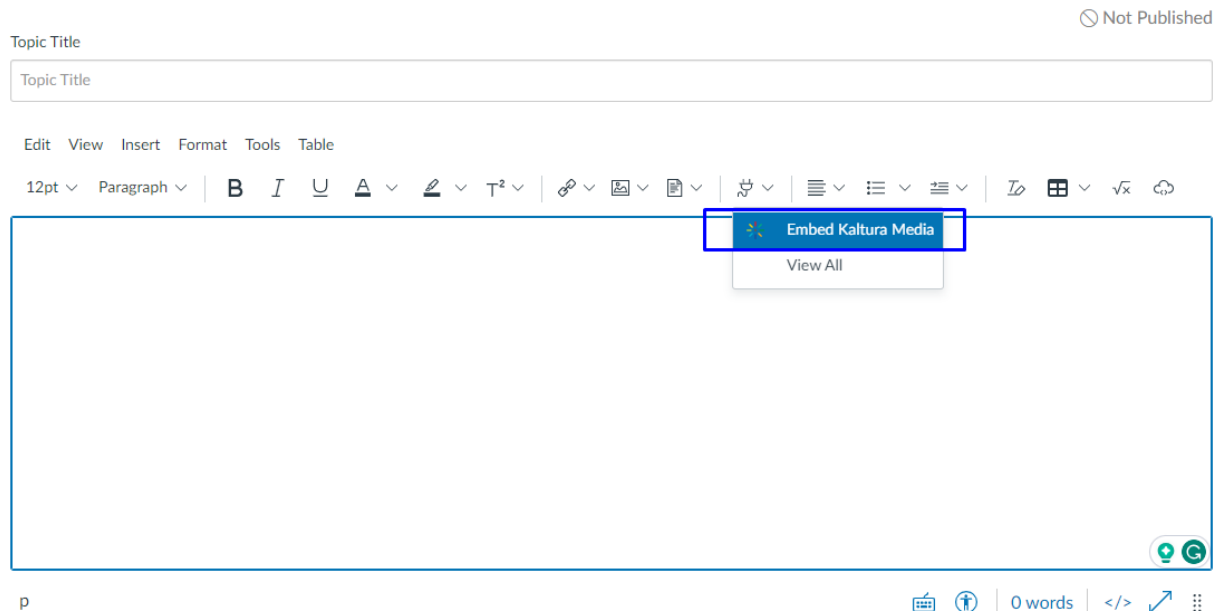
[assignmentSubmissionMaxRole](#) - Select the highest role level for which the toggle button "Submit as Assignment" displays (previous pop-up message).

End User Experience

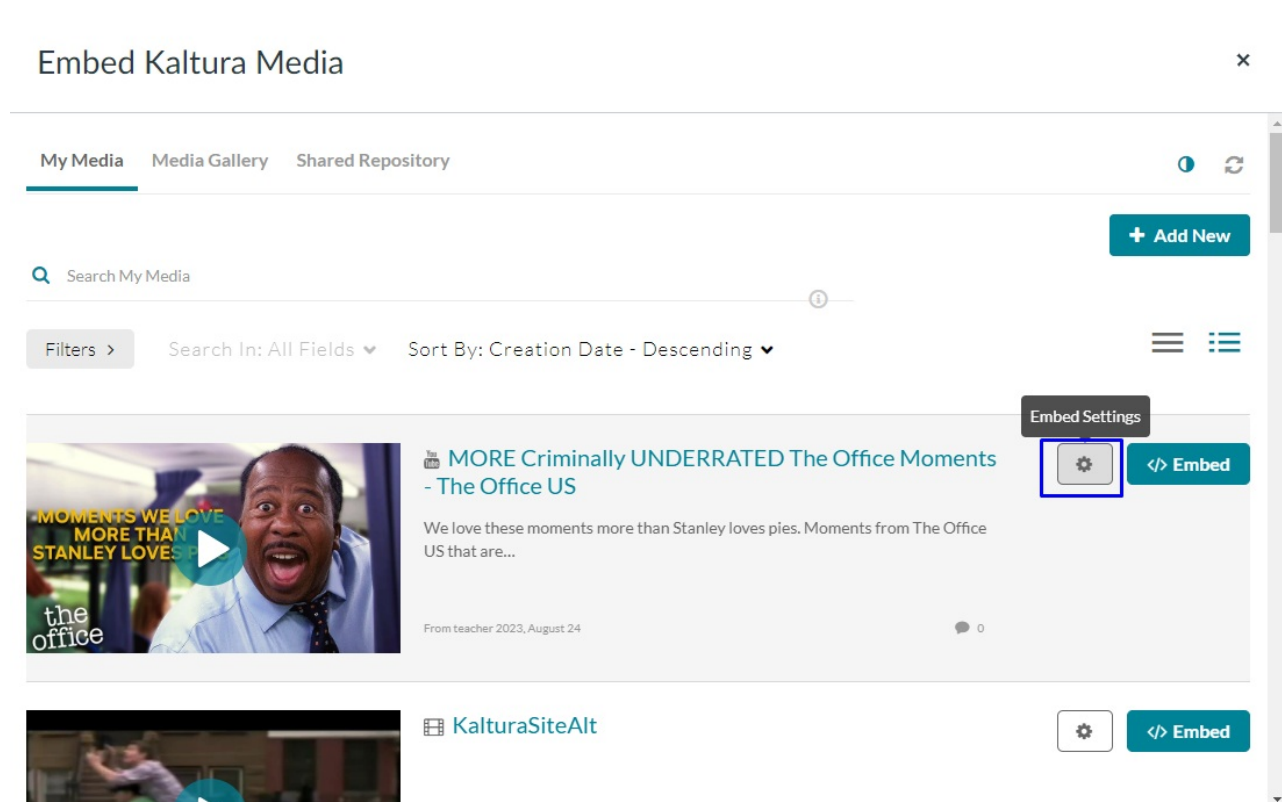
If the [enableAssignmentSubmission](#) is enabled **and** the user's role is under the defined [assignmentSubmissionMaxRole](#), every time the user selects an entry to embed in Browse, Search, and Embed, the toggle button "Submit as Assignment" displays. As

follows:

1. In the LMS course, select **Embed Kaltura Media** from the text editor. (this name may vary according to your setup)



2. Select the **Embed Settings** button next to the media you want to embed.



3. Enable the **Submit as Assignment** toggle button to embed the media as an assignment.

4. Click **Embed**.

5. A pop-up window displays, asking if you would like to submit media as an assignment.

Click **Yes, please** to confirm the action.

Dedicated Submission Embed Button

Administrators can add a dedicated Kaltura Embed button just for assignments. Using this embed flow, users do not need to select whether this is an assignment. Instead, the entry is always cloned.

Canvas

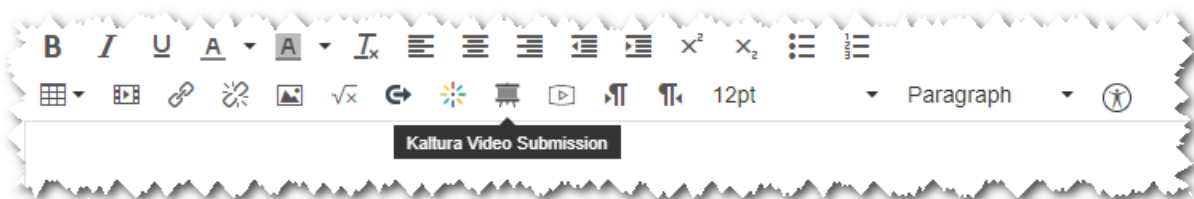


In LTI 1.3 Canvas has a limitation where only one Kaltura tool can be added per placement. If you use the BSE

tool in the Text Editor placement you will not be able to add the dedicated submission embed tool as well.

Use the additional XML available in the KAF XML list (available in https://{your_KAF_URL}/canvas/config/create-xml-for-instance) to enable the tool. For more information on how to turn on Canvas Tools, please refer to the [Canvas Deployment Guide](#).

The Kaltura Video Submission tool displays on the rich text editor as an additional icon.



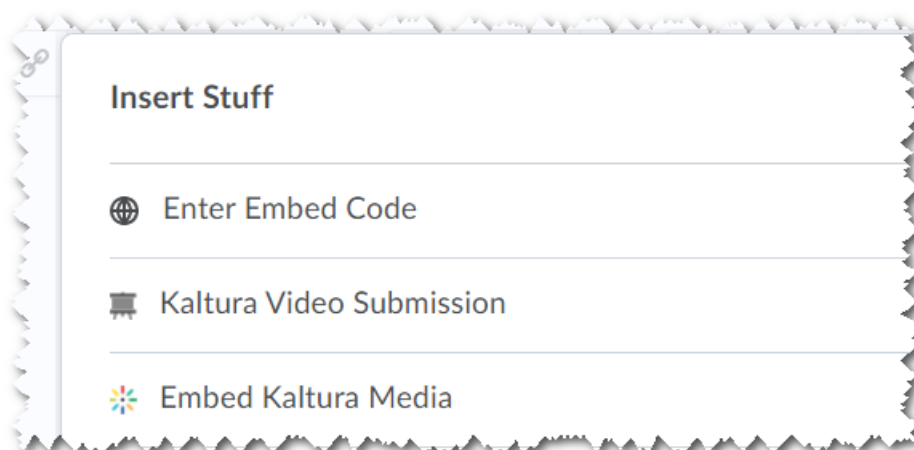
BrightSpace by D2L

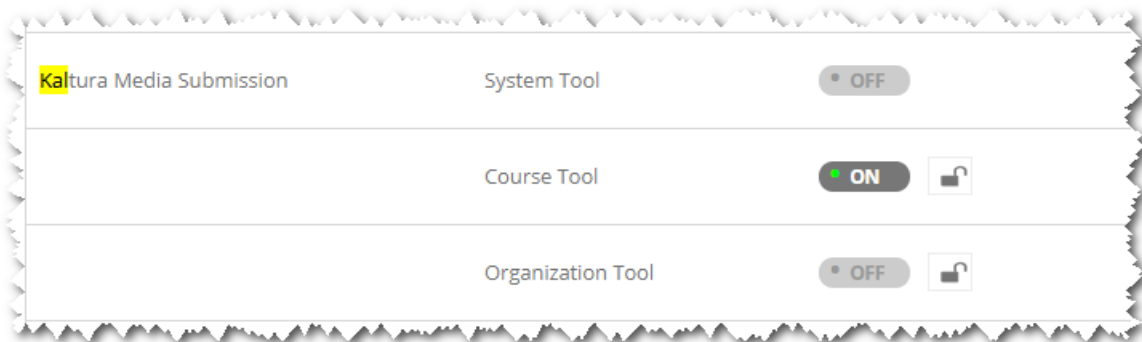

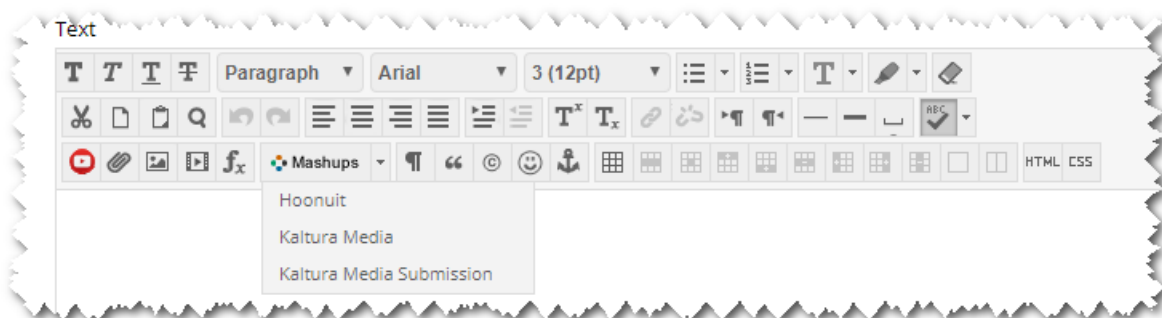



Blackboard Learn

Locate and turn on the Kaltura Media Submission tool under the Tools section in the Blackboard System Admin.



This will enable the Kaltura Media Submission under the Mashups tool list:

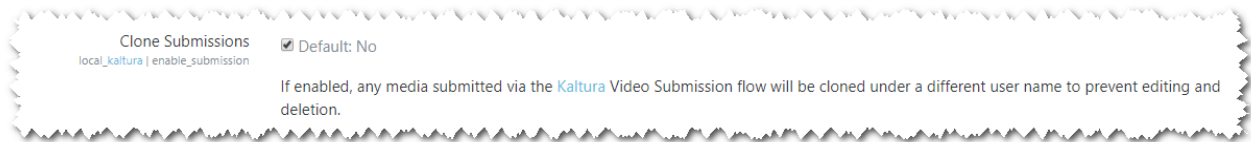
