

Create a video quiz assignment in Blackboard

About

This guide explains how to add a Kaltura Video Quiz to your Blackboard course so that student scores are automatically recorded in the Grade Center.



Adding a Kaltura Video Quiz through **Add Content** won't create a Grade Center column, so student scores won't be recorded. To ensure proper grading, always add quizzes via the **Content Market**.

Create your video quiz


1. Create a video quiz in your My Media.



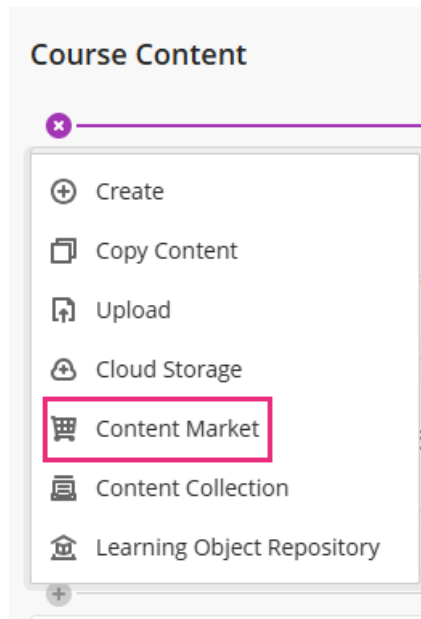

2. Go to your course.
3. In your course, navigate to the **Content** area where you want to add the quiz.
4. Click the plus (+) icon in the section where you'd like the quiz to appear.

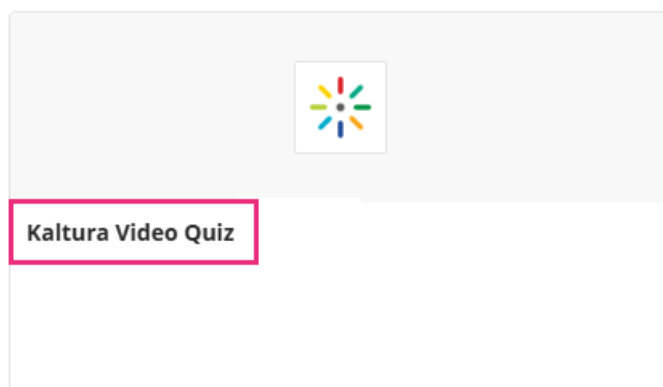

5. Select **Content Market**.



6. Click Kaltura Video Quiz (or your institution's configured tool name).



The **My Media** window opens.

7. Click **Embed** to the far right of the quiz you want to add.

The quiz name is the original video title with “- Quiz” added.

The video quiz displays in the course. You can now edit it if you want.



A Grade Center column is created automatically, and when students complete the quiz, their scores are sent directly to the Grade Center.



When students answer and submit their quizzes (see [Taking a Quiz](#)) the grade is automatically sent to the Blackboard Grade Center for the relevant assignment and student.
