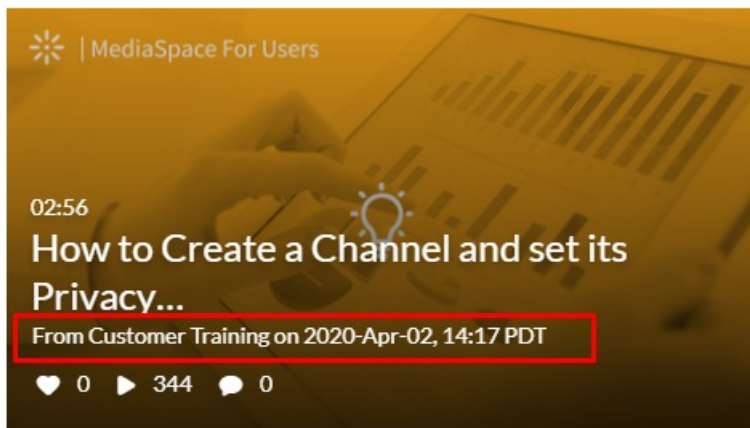


How can I remove the creator name and creation date from media?

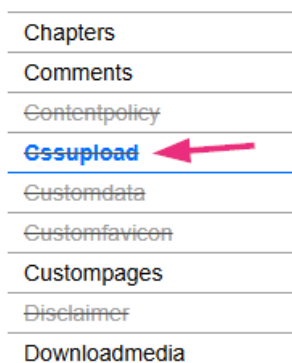

1. Log into your Configuration Management console.
2. In the left pane, locate and click on **Cssupload**.

upload a replacment bootstrap file.

- Set **enabled** to 'Yes', then scroll down and click **Save** at the bottom of the page.
