You can upload caption files for any media you own or have editing privileges for. Supported file types include SRT, DFXP, and VTT. You can also add multiple caption files to an entry, such as subtitles in different languages, and label each one accordingly.



To upload another file, click **Upload captions file** again and repeat the steps above.

Set a default captions file

If users upload their own caption files while others use REACH captioning, REACH captions are usually set as the <u>default</u>. Users who upload their own captions simply need to select the "Set as default" option after uploading.

To the far right of the desired caption file, click Set as default in the **Actions** column.

To the far right of the desired caption file, click the **download icon** in the **Actions** column.

i Kaltura captions only outputs SRT or DFXP format, not VTT. However, if you manually upload a VTT, then that becomes downloadable for others.
