Media Gallery managers have the ability to import content from other media galleries they manage. This can serve faculty members to import media from the old media gallery to the new media gallery each semester.

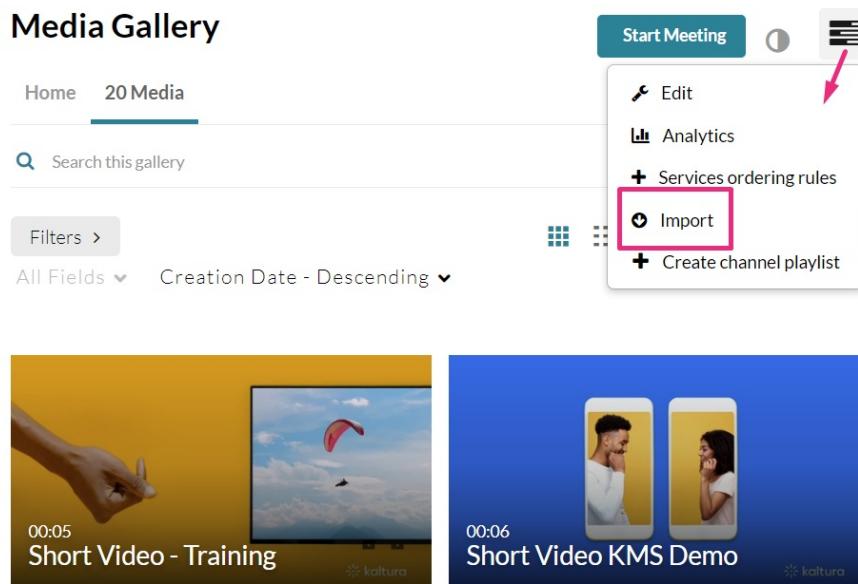
 This feature requires the [Importchannel](#) module to be enabled by your system administrator.

2. Select the **Media** tab.

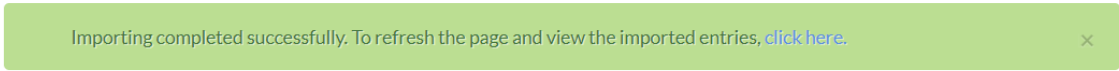

 The Channel Import feature supports the ability to import playlists, only if there are **10 or less** playlists in the channel.

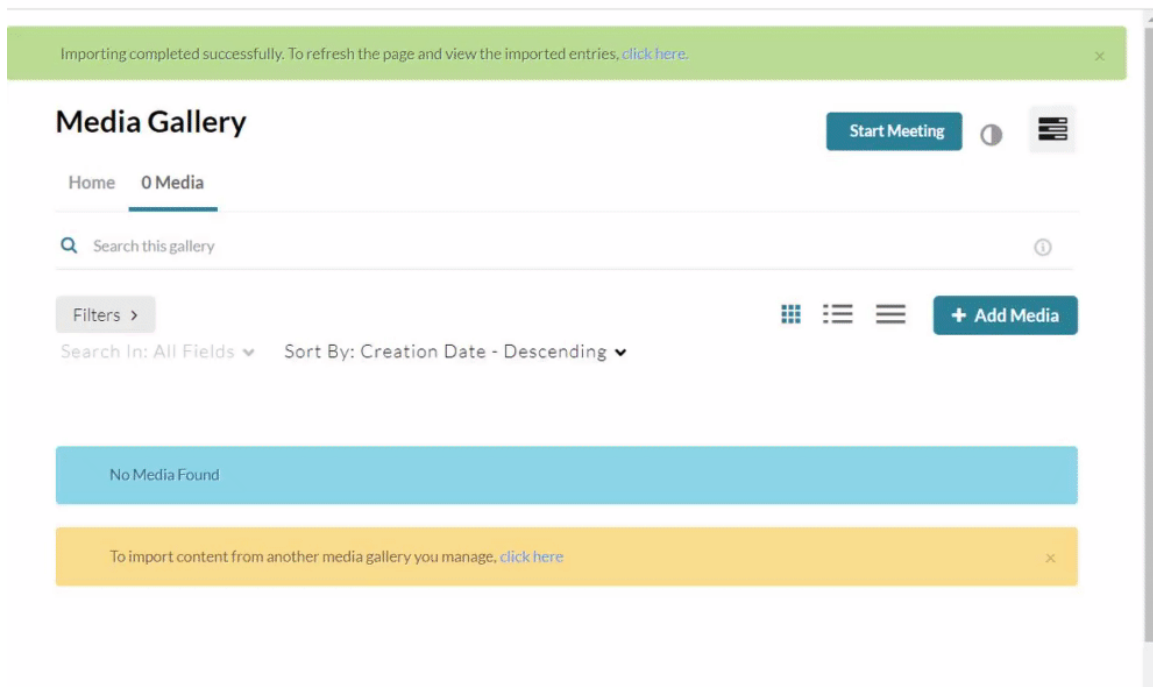
