
What's new

Automation Manager: Scheduling now uses relative dates

Media scheduling criteria in Automation Manager previously required you to select a specific date, which meant rules had to be updated manually over time.

You can now define scheduling conditions based on the current date, for example, "Start date is in more than 7 days" or "End date is less than 3 days".

This means your rules update automatically as time passes and continue to run without manual changes.



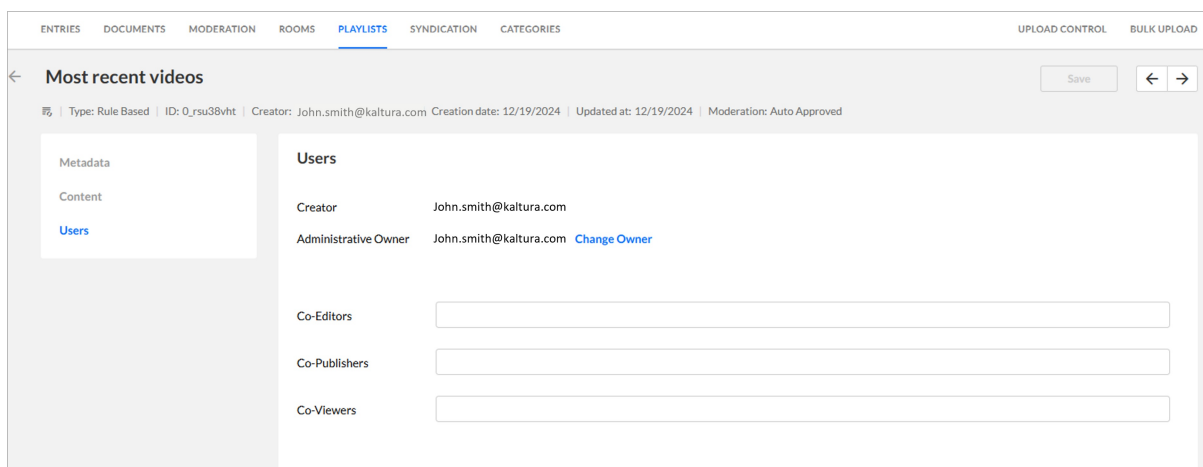

Manage playlist ownership and collaborators

You can now manage playlist users just like media entry users. A new **Users** tab in the playlist editor lets you set:

- **Owner** — the primary owner of the playlist
- **Co-editors** — users who can edit the playlist
- **Co-publishers** — users who can publish the playlist
- **Co-viewers** — users who can view the playlist but can't edit or publish

This gives teams clearer ownership and more flexible collaboration around playlist management.





Publish playlists to categories

You can now assign playlists to categories so they can be included in category-based publishing workflows, just like single media entries.

The **Categories** field can be found in the playlist's Metadata tab, with a **Browse categories** option for quick selection.

This makes it easier to organize playlists and automate how they are published and distributed.



Role permission updated to cover playlist categories

The existing KMC role permission *Modify Entry's Category* has been renamed ***Modify Entry or Playlist's Category***. This role now controls category assignment for both entries and playlists (as well as Kaltura Rooms).

No new permission is required. Admins use the same permission to control who can assign categories to playlists.

KMCNG-2846 SUP-50534	<p>KMC admin promotion now correctly handles SSO users</p> <p>In SSO environments, users are created with a hashed internal ID and their email stored as externalId. When a KMC admin tried to add such a user by email address, KMC would not find the existing SSO user and silently create a duplicate account — causing inconsistent or broken KMC access.</p> <p>KMC now checks whether an existing user's externalId matches the entered email. If a match is found, a notification is shown allowing the admin to promote that existing user to KMC admin instead of creating a new one.</p> <p>If both a matching externalId user and a user with the same login email in another partner are found, a duplicate users warning is displayed so the admin can resolve the conflict before proceeding.</p>

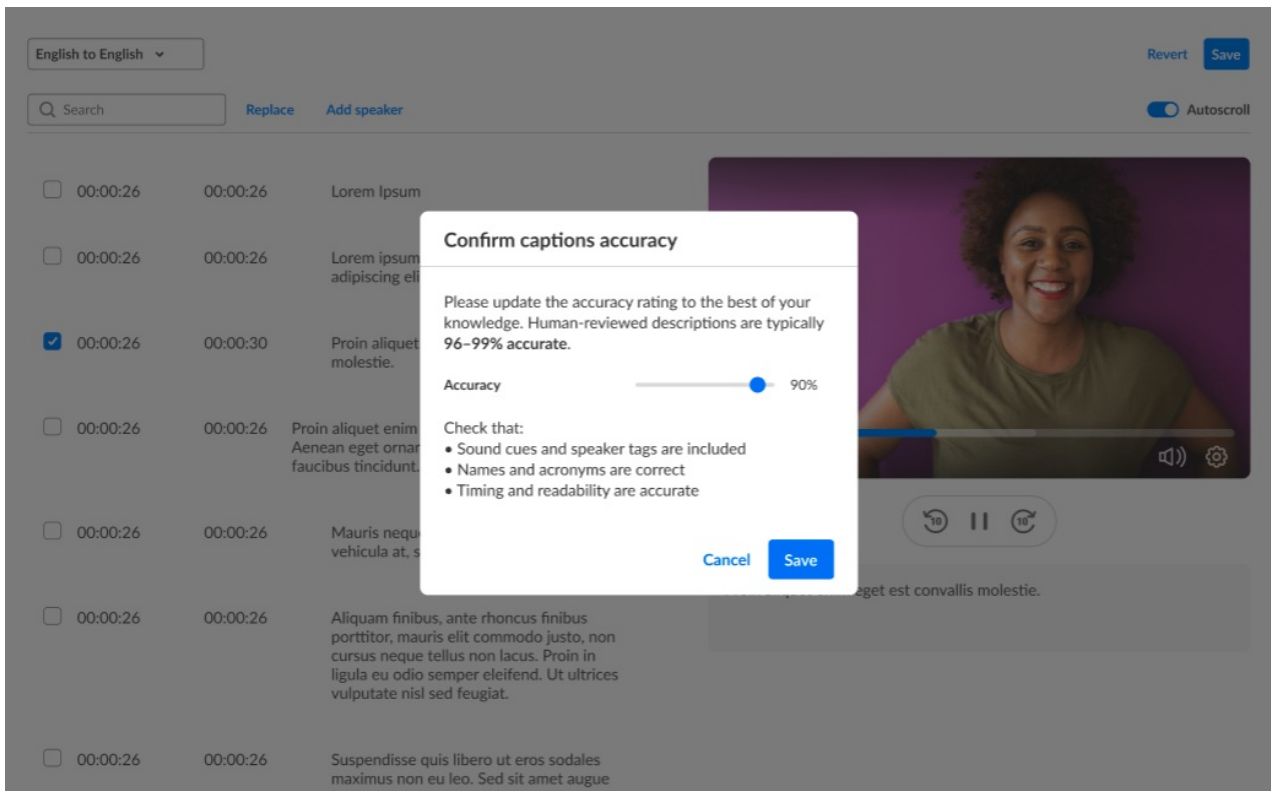

Caption accuracy confirmation

A pop-up now appears after updating captions, helping users confirm the accuracy rating before saving. This step helps ensure that each entry reflects the correct accuracy level, supporting higher standards of accessibility and content quality.

It also lays essential groundwork for upcoming features, including the Accessibility Agent - which will rely on these accuracy percentages to provide enhanced accessibility insights and automation.


New EAD (Extended Audio Description) Editor

We're excited to introduce the new Extended Audio Description (EAD) Editor. This feature enables users to directly edit VTT-based audio description files within the editor, with built-in browser speech synthesis for smooth playback during editing.

This release is an essential step toward improving content accuracy, offering precise control over the creation and management of audio descriptions. Maintaining high accuracy is critical for content quality and will also serve as the foundation for upcoming accessibility initiatives.

The EAD Editor also supports our commitment to WCAG Level AAA requirements and

reflects feedback from EDU customers who value the flexibility and control Extended Audio Descriptions provide.

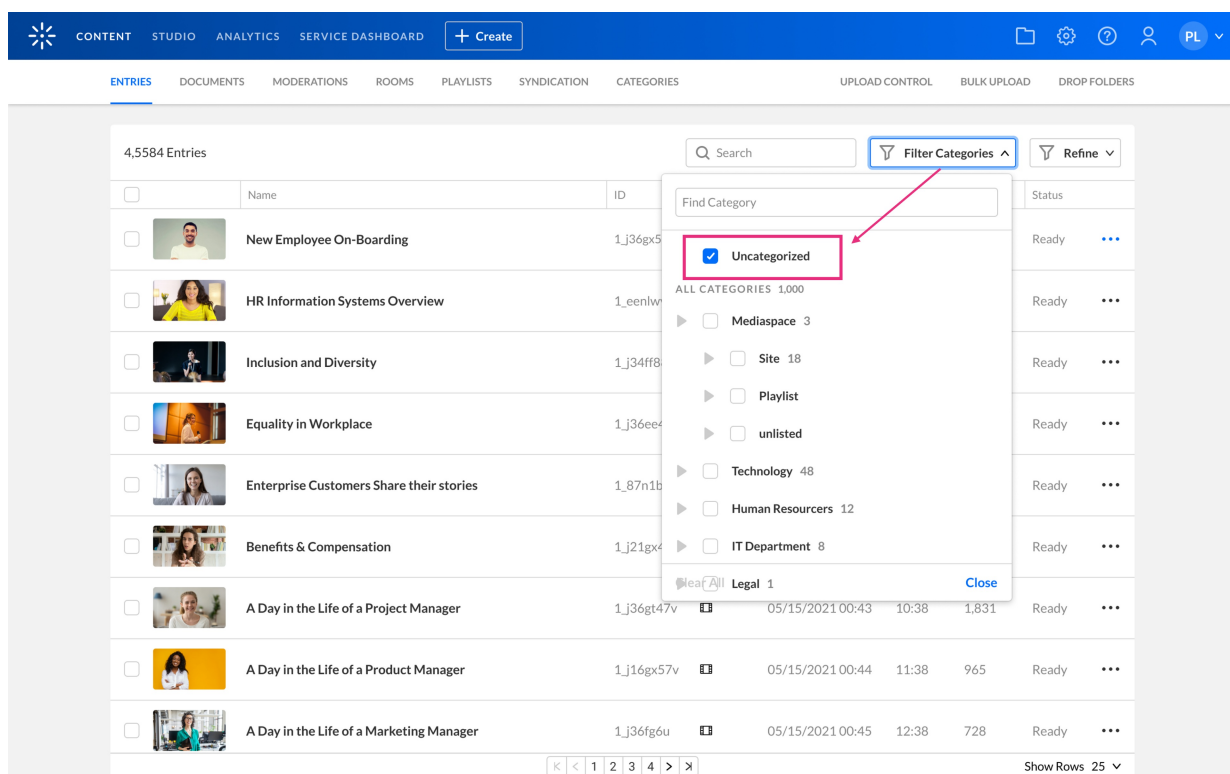

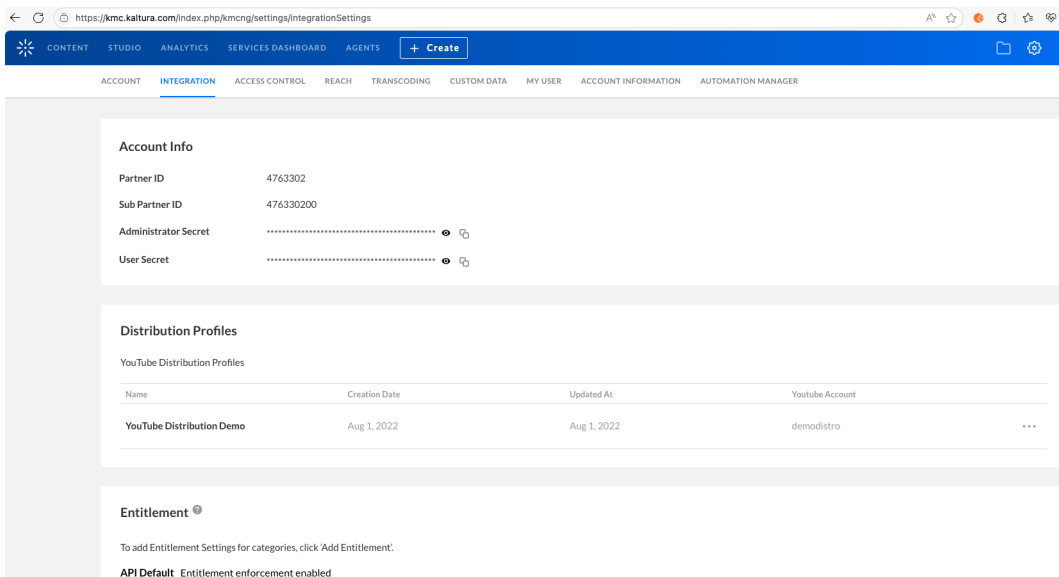

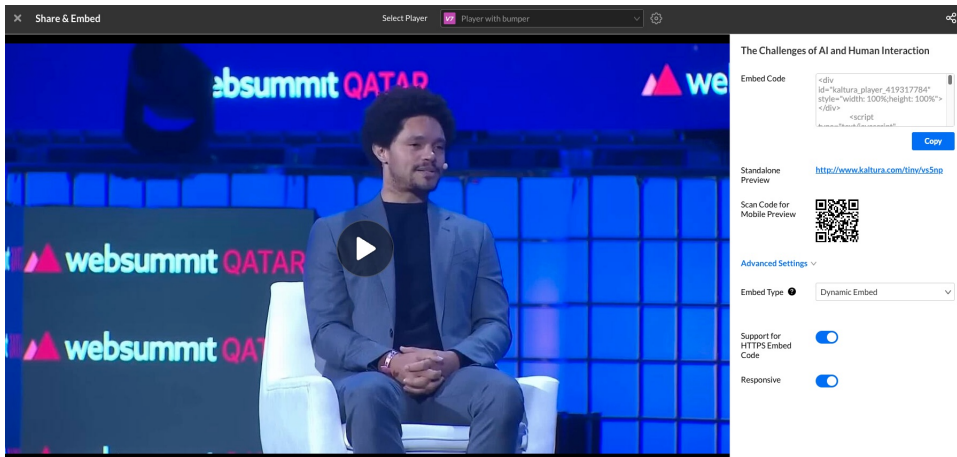
Administrator and user secrets are now automatically obfuscated in the KMC. This enhancement allows you to safely share your screen or demonstrate configurations without exposing sensitive information.



Responsive sizing toggle in Share & Embed for Player embeds

A new toggle in Share & Embed lets you generate responsive embed code for players. Replace fixed width and height values with 100% to ensure your embedded players automatically adapt to any screen size.

Note that responsive rendering requires proper container divs — embedding the code outside of a structured layout may prevent the player from displaying correctly.

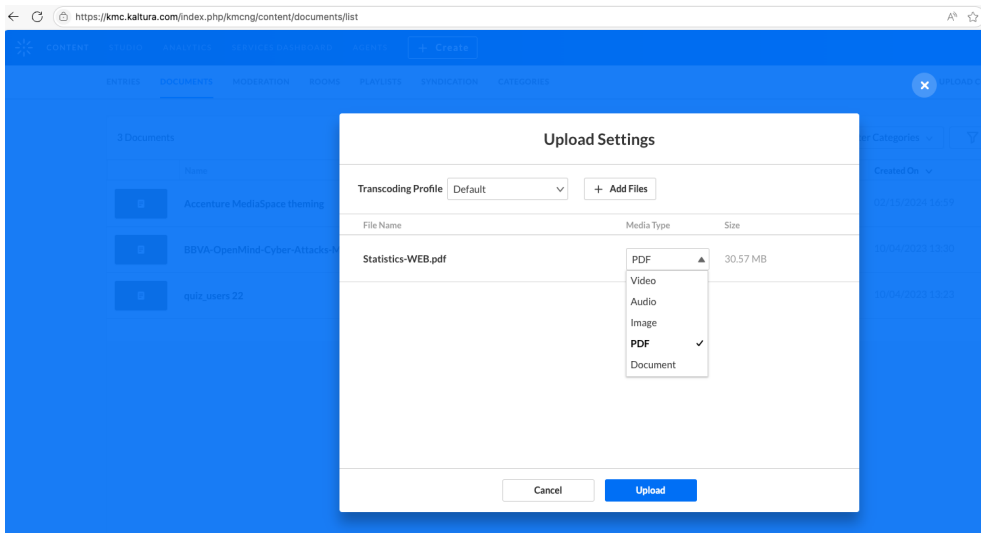

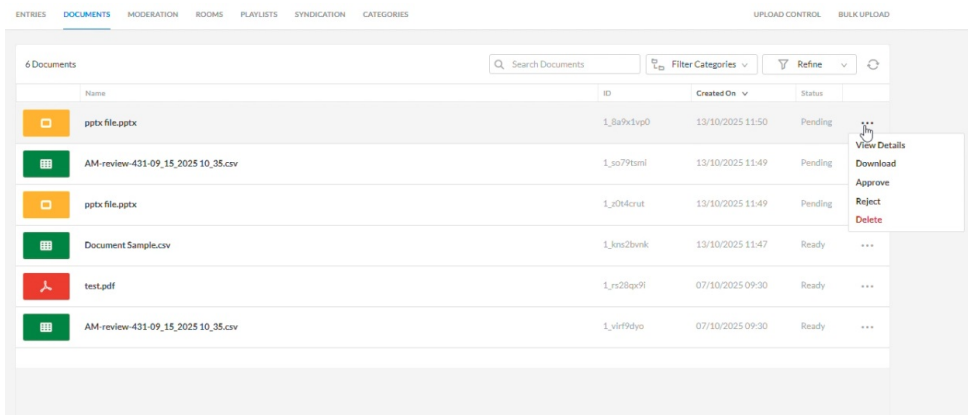

We've expanded the number of languages you can use to manually add captions to your videos. This enhancement ensures more viewers can engage with your content in their preferred language, improving accessibility, comprehension, and global reach. Captions appear directly in the video player during playback, delivering a seamless viewing experience for diverse audiences.

New supported languages

Simplified Chinese and Traditional Chinese, Australian English, Azerbaijani, Bengali, Burmese, Bosnian, Georgian, Gujarati, Javanese, Kannada, Kazakh, Khmer, Lao, Macedonian, Nepali, Persian, Punjabi, Serbian, Sinhalese, Slovakian, Sudanese, Swahili, Tagalog (Filipino), Uzbek, Xhosa.



Chinese (Simplified) and Chinese (Traditional) are now supported, enabling more inclusive communication for Chinese-speaking viewers worldwide.

10-Second viewing analytics update

The way we measure content view times has changed in our analytics dashboards to reflect 10-second interval-based metrics, which is a more accurate method for how viewers engage with content. **Minutes viewed** and **Average minutes viewed** metrics are now calculated according to the new method, while **avg. drop-off rate** has been replaced by **completion rate**, a similar metric that is based on the improved 10-second interval method.

The new viewership metrics have been already added to API reports and exports, and they will continue to include both the 10-second interval based metrics and the quartile-based metrics (the previous method of metrics).

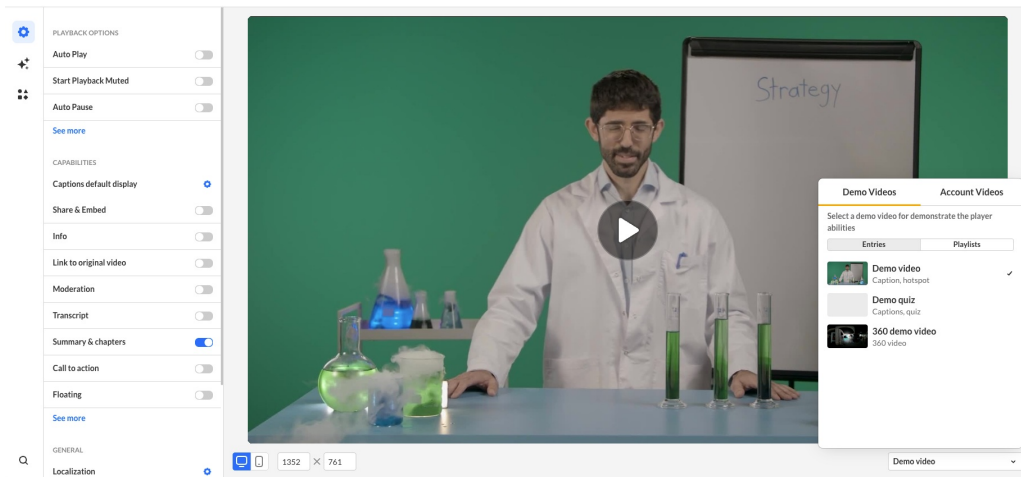

Automate Workflows with Admin tags

Admins can now create automation rules based on admin tags — allowing them to tailor workflows to match specific operational needs.


By defining admin tag fields that reflect content sources (e.g., Zoom, WebEx, Teams, Idomoo), admins can apply actions to highly specific content groups - making automation more precise and efficient.

For example, a rule can be set to add a category to entries that have the admin tag “zoom” set - helping publishing content to the intended audiences.

How it works:

- Create or edit a rule - including any fields relevant to your workflows.
- In the Rule, add a criteria and select “Entry admin tags”.
- Enter the exact value that should activate or exclude the rule (e.g., “zoom”).

This gives admins more control over how and when content is handled - based on the admin tag they define.

Automate Workflows with hidden entries

Previously, VOD rule types could only match parent entries. If a parent entry was deleted, any linked child entries would remain orphaned, often referred to as “zombie” entries.

With this update, admins can now create VOD rule types with new actions.

This helps:

- To choose how to deal with hidden entries that are linked as child entries to one main parent entry (i.e. zoom recordings)

Automate workflows with Custom Metadata - Admins can now create automation rules based on their own custom metadata — allowing them to tailor workflows to match specific operational needs.

By defining metadata fields that reflect internal policies or content management rules (e.g., archival status, deletion exemptions), admins can apply actions to highly specific content groups - making automation more precise and efficient.

For example, a rule can be set to delete entries that haven't been played for 4 years and don't have the custom metadata field "donotdelete" set - helping clear out unused content while protecting important exceptions.

How it works:

- Set up a custom metadata schema - including any fields relevant to your workflows.
- In the Automation Manager, select the schema and field to use as a trigger.
- Enter the exact value that should activate or exclude the rule (e.g., "donotdelete").

This gives admins more control over how and when content is handled - based on the metadata they define.



Multi-Category publishing for Zoom recordings - Until now, Zoom recordings uploaded via integration could be published to just one category in the Management Console.

With this update, admins can now publish recordings to multiple categories at once.

This helps:

- Keep content better organized
- Make recordings easier to find across different channels
- Match each recording to multiple relevant categories (e.g., team, topic, or course)
