

Media page interactions

The availability of likes, plays, views, and comments depends on how your video portal is configured in the [Application module](#) and [Comments module](#).

- **Likes** - Users can like or unlike media. Likes can be performed only from the media page.
- **Plays** - Plays represent actual video playback.
- **Comments** - Comments appear below the media on the media page.
- **Views** - For **image** entries, shows how many times the image was viewed.
