
There are two ways to reset all configurations of the CSS back to Kaltura defaults.

Method 1

1. On the KMS Admin Configuration Management page, navigate to the [Styling](#) module.
2. Click the **Reset** button to the right of isCcssApplied to reset, or clear, all previously set styles.

Method 2

1. On the KMS Admin Configuration Management page, navigate to the [Styling](#) module.
2. Click the **Styling Page** link to the right of the description in the Module Info box.
3. From the **Actions** pull-down list, select **Restore Defaults**.
