You will need to unpublish the media to remove media from a gallery. In this article we'll show you two ways to do this:


- via the edit page
- via the entry page

Unpublish media via the edit page


- 1. Log into your Video Portal site (aka MediaSpace).
- 2. Find the gallery you want to remove media from on the navigation bar and click on it.




The gallery page displays.



3. Hover on the thumbnail of the media you want to remove and click the three dots that appear in the bottom right corner.



4. A pencil icon appears in the bottom left corner. Click the icon.



The Edit page displays.

5. Select the **Publish** tab.



Set the media to **Private**. This will unpublish the media from all categories/channels and all other applications.

Publishing Status:

- Private Media page will be visible to the content owner only.
- O Unlisted Media page will be visible to anyone with a link to the page.
- O Published Media page will be visible to users according to entitlements based on the selected destinations in the options below.

If you want to retain the media published under other categories or channels, leave the published status unchanged, and simply uncheck the desired gallery or sub-galleries to unpublish them.





Unpublish media via the entry page

- 1. Log into your video portal.
- 2. Locate the gallery you want to remove media from on the navigation bar and click on it.

The gallery page displays.




Click the thumbnail of the media you want to remove.
