

## Channel entitlements

This article is designated for administrators.

### About

When setting up a channel via the Video Portal, users have an option to select the respective Privacy. If administrators (not channel owners) are requested to change the channel entitlements (for example, changing a Restricted channel to a Public, Open channel), you can do it from KMC.

### Access the Entitlements page

1. Log into KMC.
2. Choose the **Categories** tab.
3. Find the category you want to configure and click the **three dots menu** at the end of the row.
4. Choose **Edit** from the drop-down menu.
