

Gap analysis: Video Portal moving to Content Hubs

About

This article outlines the current gaps between the **legacy Video Portal** and **Content Hubs**, the Theming-based Video Portal experience.

Content Hubs refers to the Video Portal when the Theming design system is enabled (in other words, legacy Video Portal + Theming = Content Hubs).

The list below highlights features that are not available or have changed in the Theming experience:

Current feature gaps

Media page & edit experience

- Ability to add comments on non-scheduled media.
- Registration forms for single entries will not be supported.

Channel page & edit experience

- Ability to select different players per channel.
- Ability to set and display tags on channels.
- Channel topics will not be supported ([Channel Collections](#) now serve this purpose).

Channels and galleries

- Ability to assign a channel to one or more galleries.
- Action buttons (for example, 'Edit', 'Analytics') and media details (for example, 'owner', likes) will not be displayed on media thumbnails.



Upload

- Ability to add collaborators (co-editors, co-publishers, and co-viewers) during upload.

Media page

- Some “Add to” actions are not available.

My Media

- Some actions are missing from the 'actions' menu (**three dots**), for example, 'Add to Playlist' and 'Captions'.
- Bulk actions: 'Captions & enrichment', 'Set metadata', 'Add/Remove tags'.
- Table or collapsed views (only the detailed view is available).

Single media edit

- Ability to add chapters and slides (timeline editor).
- Language tab is not yet available.
