## Configure

### Enable Userreports module

1. Go to your KMS or KAF admin page, and navigate to the [Userreports module](#). Your link should look like this: `https://{your_KMS_URL}/admin/config/tab/userreports`.

num_days	<input type="text" value="30"/>	Default number of days. Only relevant for Quiz analytics OR Live Analytics OR Custom Reports.
page_size	<input type="text" value="20"/>	Default page size. Only relevant for Quiz analytics OR Live Analytics OR Custom Reports.

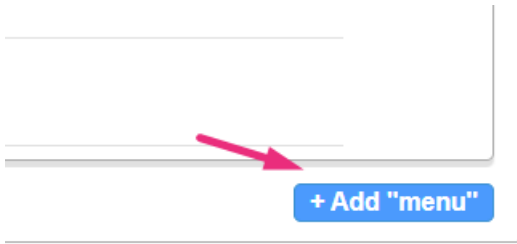
2. In the headermenu window, make sure the module is enabled (set to 'Yes').

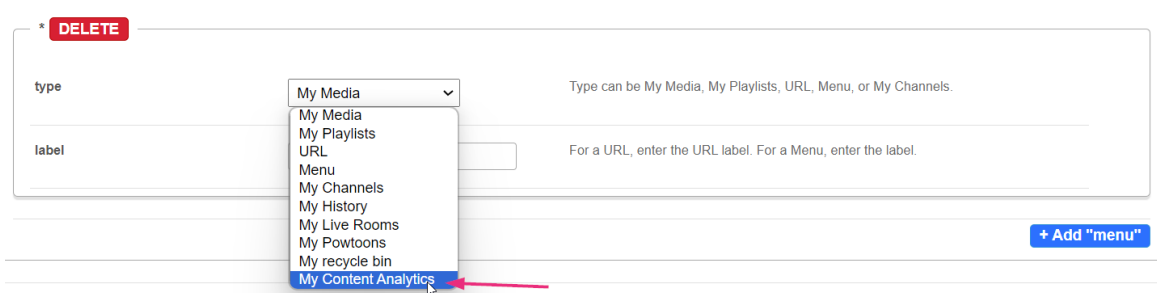

1. Click the **+Add "menu"** button.

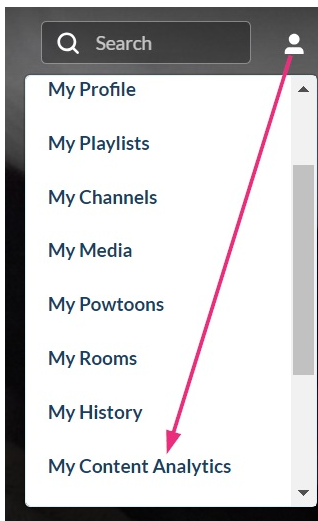


2. In the **type** drop-down menu, choose **My Content Analytics**.
