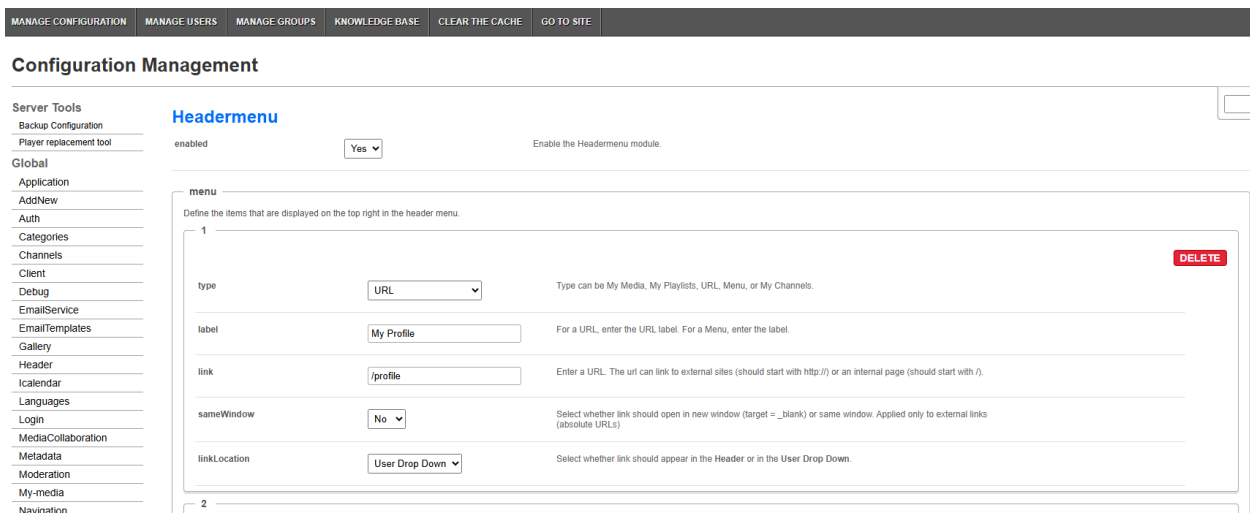

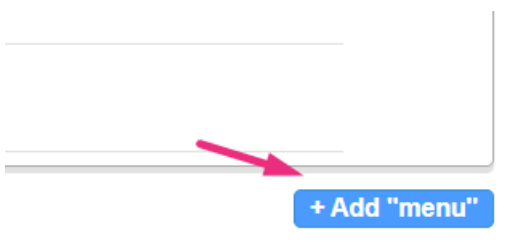

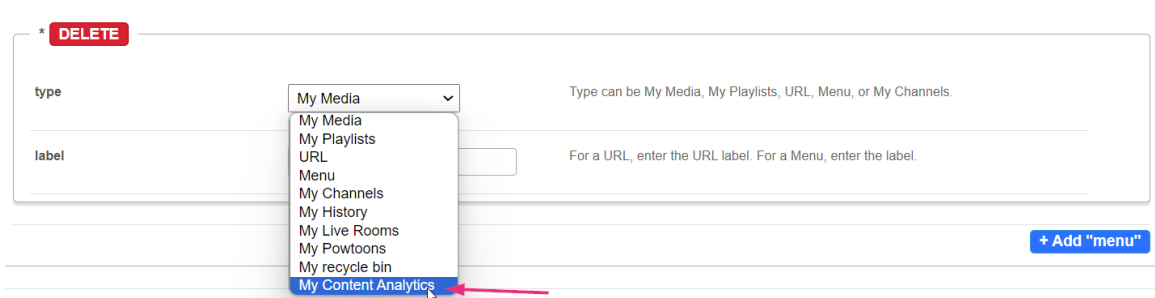

3. Click the **+Add "menu"** button.



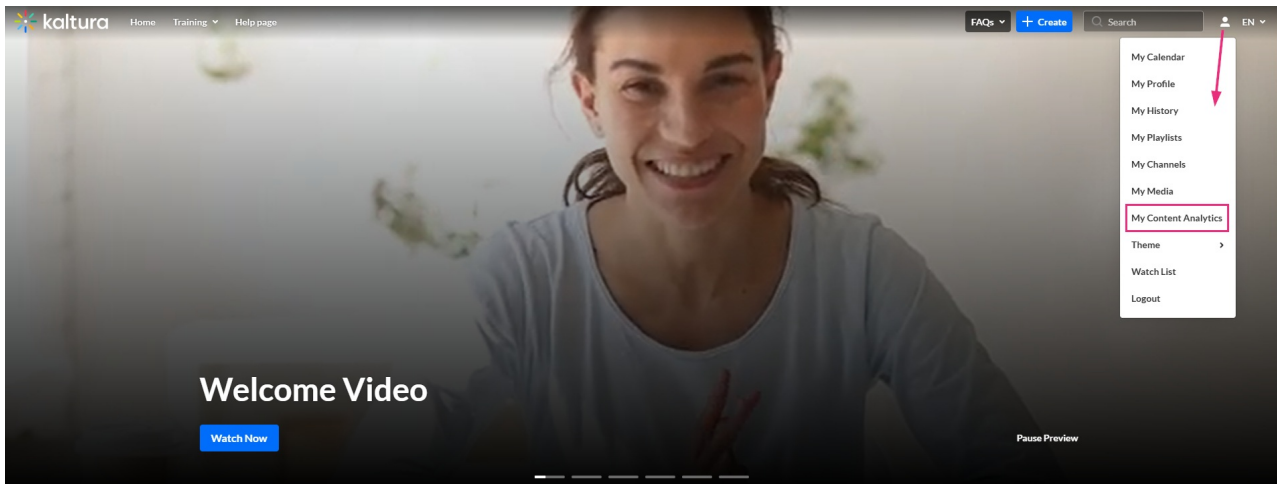
4. In the **type** drop-down menu, choose **My Content Analytics**.
