The My Content analytics dashboard enables you to discover how your users engage with a specific entry so you can track and optimize your content. The dashboard can be used to explore engagement in different time periods as well as compare different periods. You can also filter based on a variety of parameters.

Configure the User reports module

1. Go to your Configuration Management console, and click on the [Userreports module](#). You can also navigate directly using a link:

page_size	<input type="text" value="20"/>	Default page size. Only relevant for Quiz analytics OR Live Analytics OR Custom Reports.

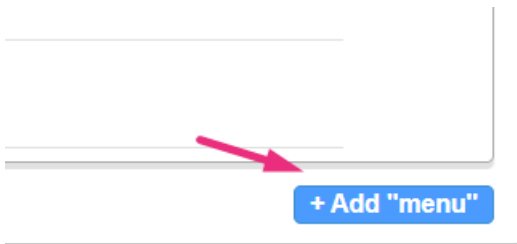
2. In the headermenu window, make sure the module is enabled (set to 'Yes').

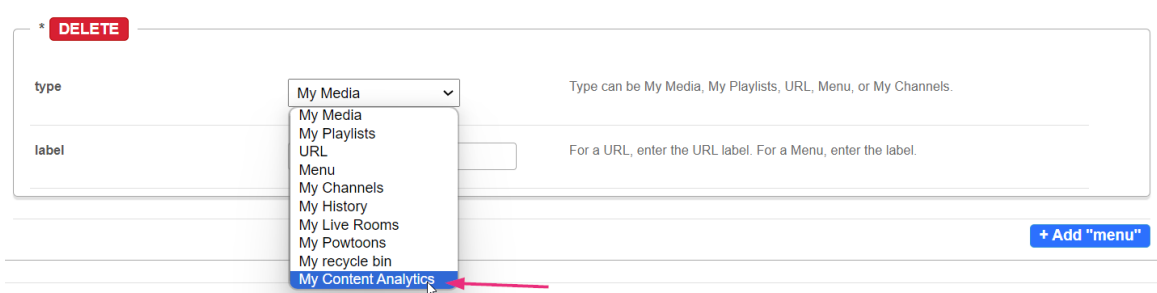

1. Click the **+Add "menu"** button.

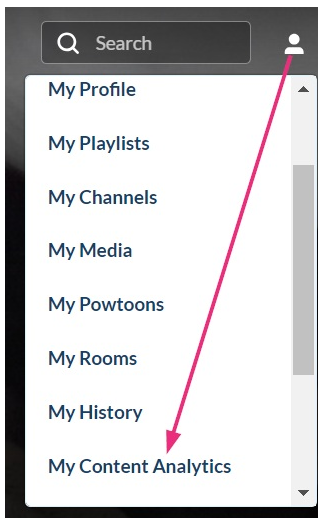


2. In the **type** drop-down menu, choose **My Content Analytics**.
