

Canvas LTI 1.3 change - July 2023

Lately, Canvas announces they are performing an LTI 1.3 change: [link](#).

In general, the Canvas change is not a breaking change. Without taking any action everything would still continue to work.

If you wish to make sure your Kaltura connection is aligned with the Canvas change, please check:

- If you configured KAF according to our [documentation](#) (sections 1.4, 1.5, 1.6) and used your Canvas instance domain (e.g. [canvas.school.edu](#)) - no action is needed at this point and your Kaltura connection is aligned with the Canvas change.
- If you configured KAF using Instructure's global domain name (i.e. [canvas.instructure.com](#)) - we recommend changing the domain name to the new Canvas domain [sso.canvaslms.com](#). This is how you can do that:

The change should be made in your KAF admin in the hosted module in these three fields:

1. ***Iti13PlatformOidcAuthUrl***: Change from
“https://canvas.instructure.com/api/lti/authorize_redirect” to
“https://sso.canvaslms.com/api/lti/authorize_redirect”
2. ***Iti13AuthTokenUrl***: Change from
“<https://canvas.instructure.com/login/oauth2/token>” to
“<https://sso.canvaslms.com/login/oauth2/token>”
3. ***Iti13KeysUrl***: Change from “<https://canvas.instructure.com/api/lti/security/jwks>” to
“<https://sso.canvaslms.com/api/lti/security/jwks>”
