About

The **Adminaccess** module gives administrators greater control over which KMC users can access the Video Portal or KAF Configuration Management pages. By default, once enabled, only users with the Publisher Administrator role can access these admin pages via the “/admin” URL. However, additional configurations allow you to grant access to other KMC users as needed.

Configure

1. Go to your KMS or KAF Configuration Management console, and click the **Adminaccess** module. Or navigate directly using a link:
https://{your_KMS_URL}/admin/config/tab/adminaccess.




2. Configure the following:

authorizedGroups - Select the groups who are allowed to access this application's admin pages.


- Click **+Add "authorizedGroups"**.
