### About

This module provides the ability to display the scheduled content of **Main Stage** - an interactive agenda that guides viewers through an event, ensuring nothing is missed. The agenda appears in the side panel, featuring vertical navigation for effortless browsing of all scheduled sessions.

Once the ChannelTV module is enabled, a new checkbox field named "Enable the channel TV for sessions on this channel" will be added to the [channel edit page](#) in the video portal, allowing channel owners to enable or disable the ChannelTV feature.



Only entries within the context of the video portal channel will display in the Main Stage. Entries published in multiple places won't appear in the agenda unless viewed within the specific channel context.




This module is exclusive to Events. The **eventplatformcore module** must also be enabled for this module to work.

#### Description

This Module provides the ability to display the scheduled content of a channel in a form of a TV channel, allowing the users to pass automatically between the sessions in the channel, and view the 'TV guide' in a vertical navigation.

A KMS only module. Available for events only.
