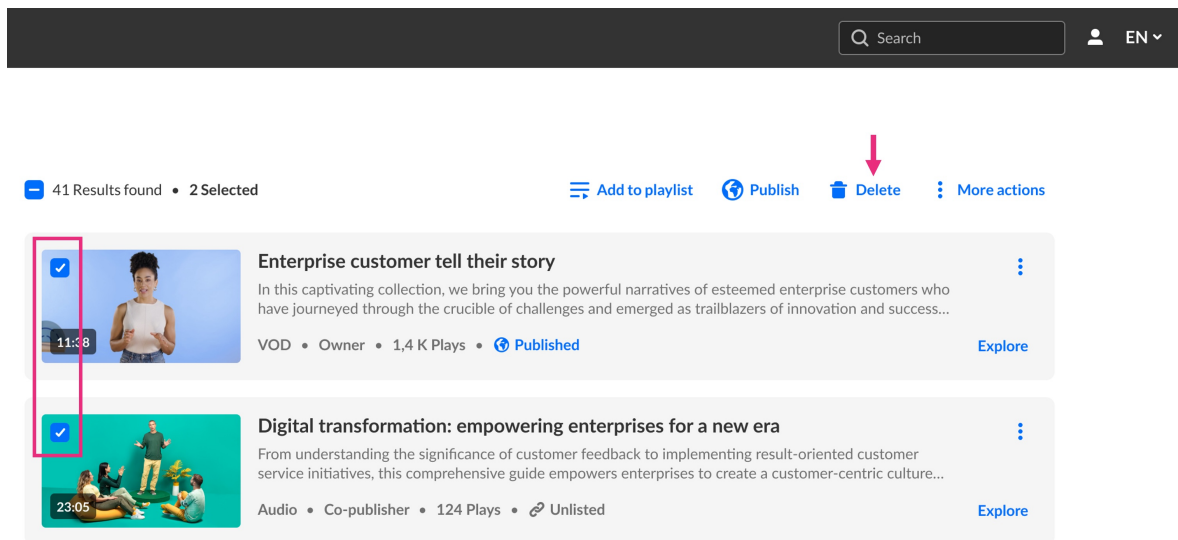
3. Click **Delete**.

The **Delete** option only displays after you have selected at least one item.



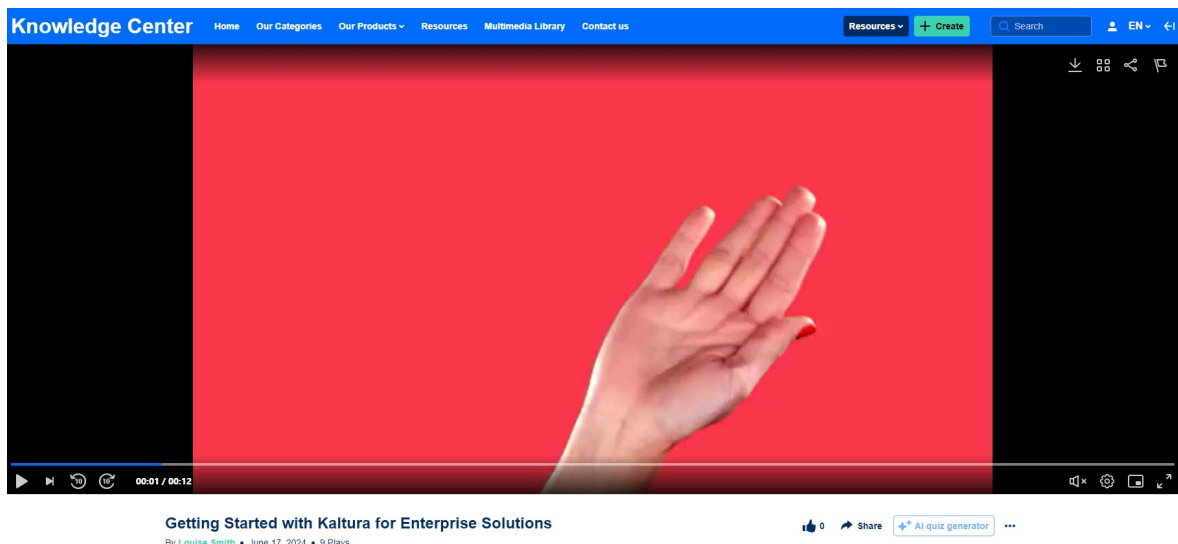

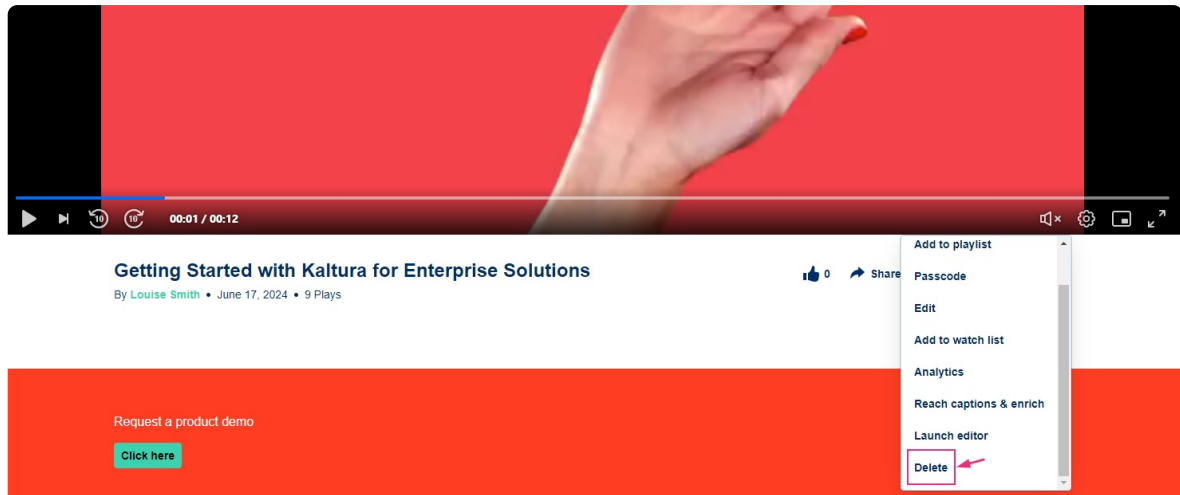
## From the media page
