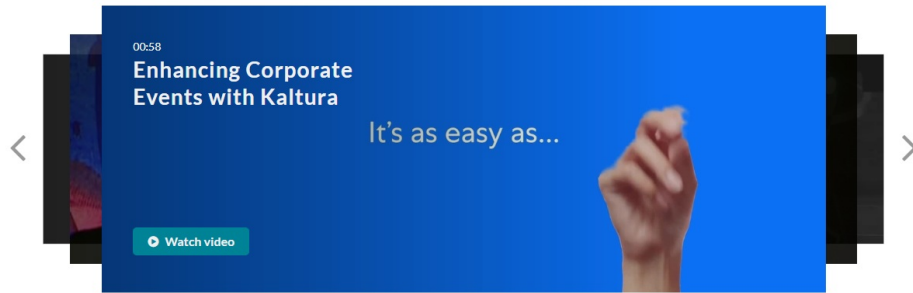
Prerequisite

Before getting started, make sure you have a private channel set up in your Video Portal with the content you want to embed. To learn more about setting up channels, visit our article [Create a new channel](#).

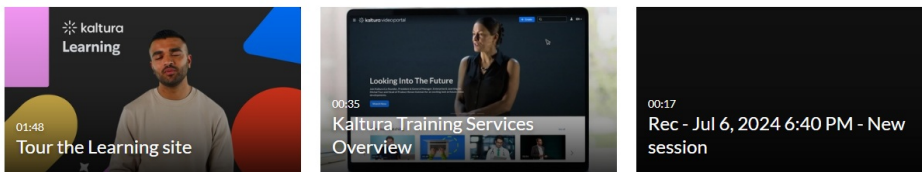
Copy the embed link from Video Portal content

1. Log into your Video Portal. If you need help, follow the instructions in our article [Log into your Video Portal](#).

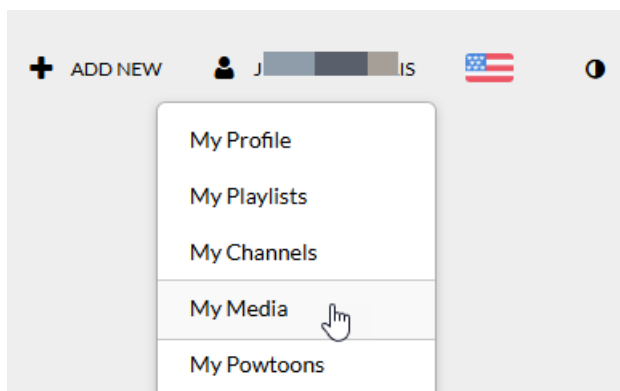
The Video Portal homepage displays.

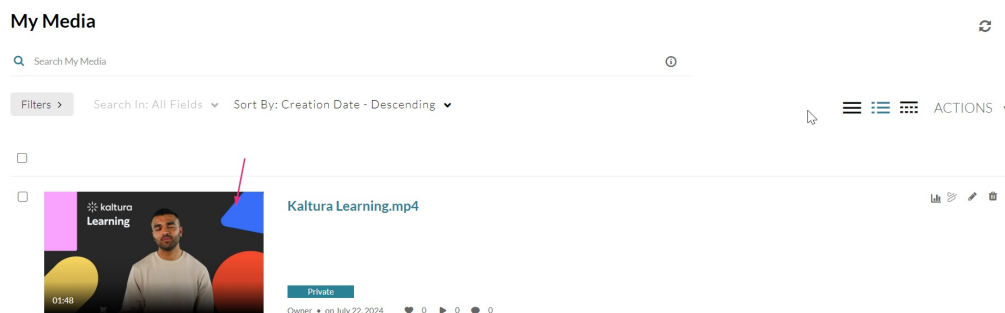


2. On the homepage of the Video Portal, choose **My Media** from the user drop-down menu.

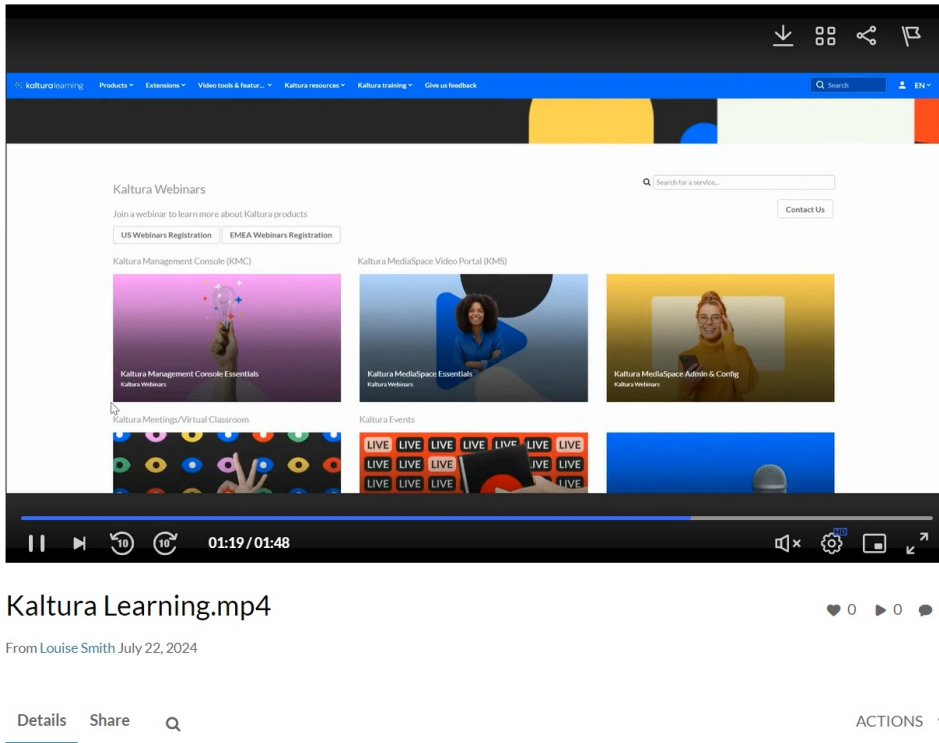


The **My Media** page displays.

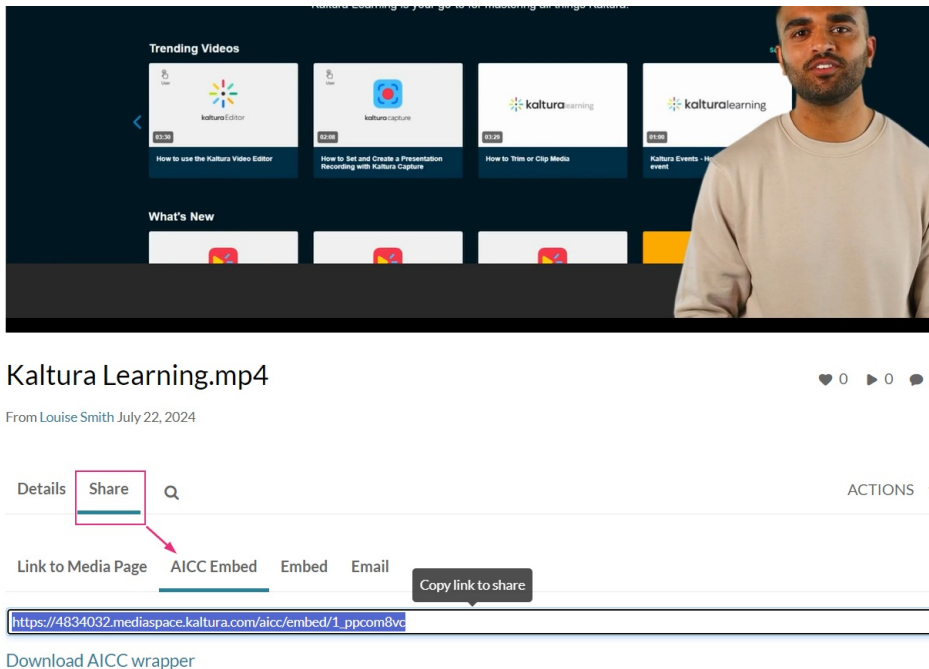
3. Click on the thumbnail or name of the desired media.



The entry page displays.



4. Below the media, click on the **Share** tab.
5. Click on the **AICC Embed** tab (the tab's name is set by your administrator).



6. Copy the URL. This URL includes the current Video Portal instance and the entry ID required to link back to the relevant section in the Video Portal.



If the AICC embed tab is not displayed, contact your Kaltura Account Representative. They need to set **enabledContextAccessRestriction** to 'No' in the Configuration Management section of the Video Portal.

Embed content into an AICC-compliant LMS

Each AICC-compliant LMS is different and the process for embedding content varies depending on the product. Following is a brief overview of how to do it using Saba Cloud.

Import content into Saba Cloud

1. Log into Saba Cloud.
2. From the upper left-hand menu, choose **Admin**.
3. Click on **Learning Admin**.
4. Click on **Manage Content**.
5. In the **Content Library**, click on desired folder and click Import.
6. Type name and **Security Domain**.
7. Choose AICC from **Content Format**.
8. Type Player Template.
9. Select **All Devices** from Mobile Device Compatibility.
10. Select **Video** from Content Type.
11. Type version number.
12. Expiration Date.
13. Click **Use as Evaluation** if desired.
14. Click **Next**.
15. Paste your AICC link into the URL field.
16. Click **Import**.

Add content to a class in Saba Cloud

1. Return to the homepage of Saba Cloud.
2. From the upper left-hand menu, choose **Admin**.
3. Click on **Learning Admin**.
4. Click on **Manage Classes**.
5. In the **Classes** section, search for and click on desired class.
6. Click on the **Activities** tab.
7. Click **Add Activities > Attach Content**.
8. Click **Browse**.

9. Click on the media that you uploaded.
10. Click **Add Activities**.
11. Click **Save**.
12. Click **Save and Publish**.
13. Check all the boxes in the push activities pop-up window and click **Save** to make this item available to existing users.
