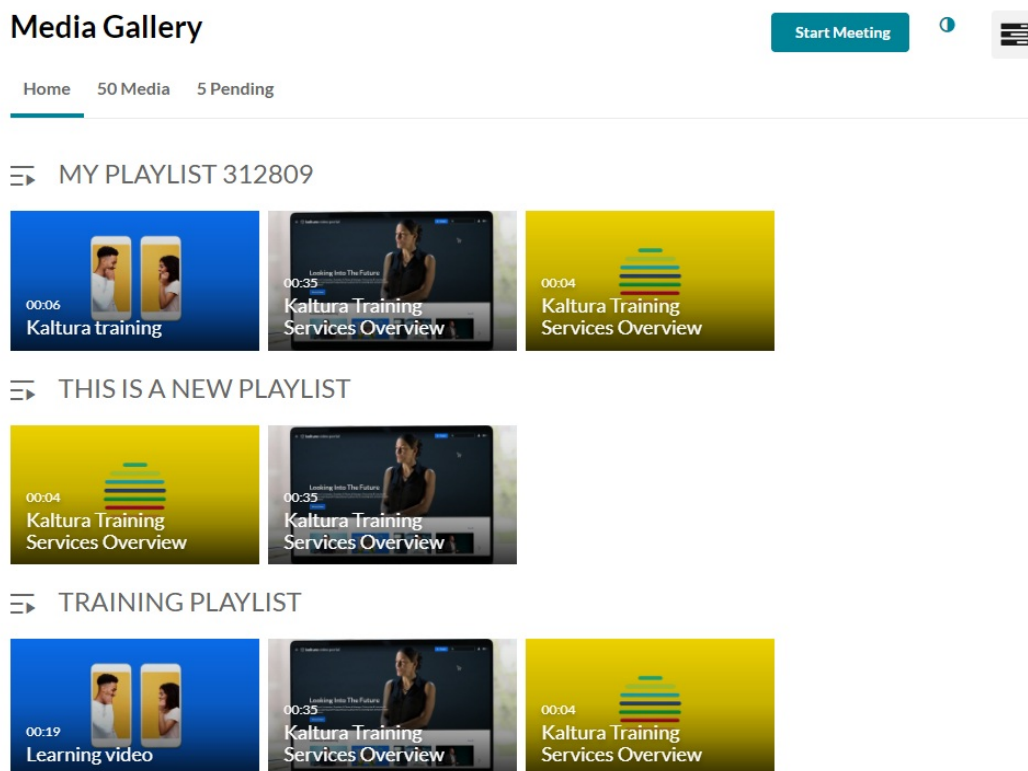
About

1. Access the Media Gallery.



2. At the top right of the Media Gallery, click the hamburger menu and select **Edit**.

Edit

1. Click the **pencil icon** next to the playlist you want to modify.
The **Edit Playlist** page displays.



2. Edit your playlist details as desired.
The following features are available on the edit playlist page:



- Media thumbnails (1)
- Playlist name (2) - Click in the field to edit the name.
- Creator, number of items in the playlist, and when it was last updated (3)
- Description (4) - Click in the description field to edit the text. Use the scroll bar on the right if there's a lot of text.
- Tags (5) - Click on the 'x' to the right of the tag name to delete it. Click in the tag

field to type in new tags.

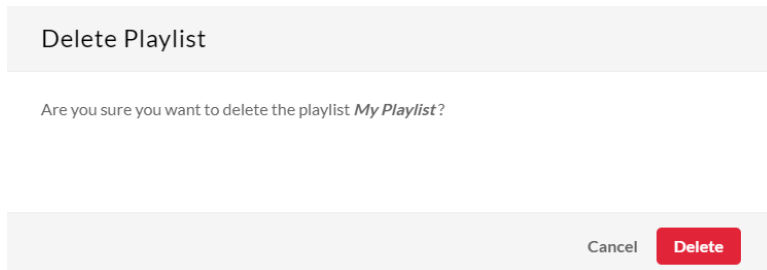
- 'Add items to your playlist' column (6) - Add media to your playlist. See [Create a playlist](#) for further information.
- 'My Playlist' column (7) -This section displays all items currently in the playlist. You can remove items or change their order as needed. For more details, see our article 'Create a playlist'.

3. After you have finished editing the playlist, click **Save** at the top right.

Delete

1. Click the **trash icon** next to the relevant playlist to delete it.

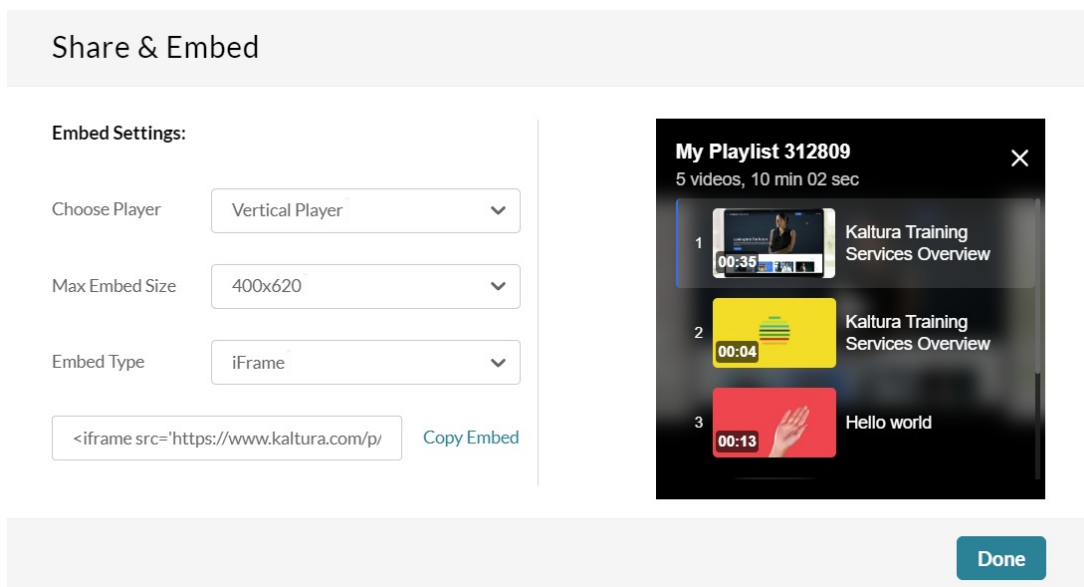
A confirmation message displays: *Are you sure you want to delete the playlist [name]?*



2. Click **Delete**.

Share and embed

1. Click the **embed icon** next to the relevant playlist to share and embed it. The **Share & Embed** window displays.





2. Configure the following settings:

- **Embed Settings:**

- **Choose Player** - Choose the player in which to embed the media
- **Max Embed Size** - Set the maximum size playlist to grab. This is set to responsive embed automatically.
- **Embed Type** - Choose the type of embed (iFrame, Dynamic, or Auto).
- To copy the embed code, click **Copy Embed**.

3. When you are finished making your selections, click **Done**.
