Registration forms can be added to the following entry types:

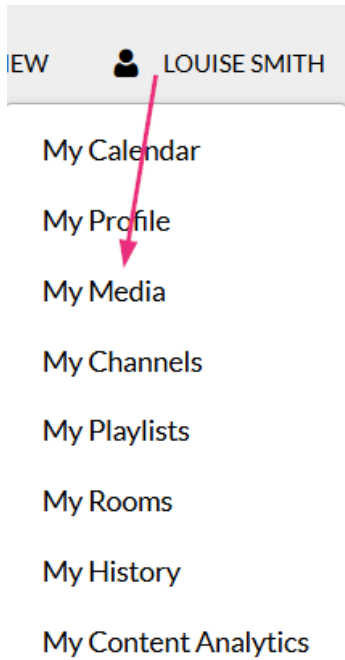
- Webcast

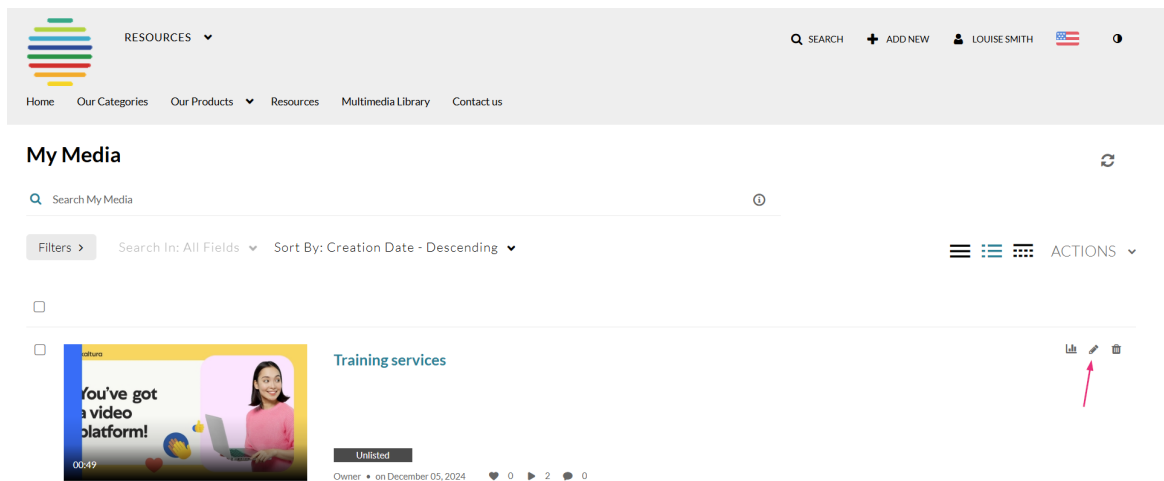
## Access the registration page

1. Access the desired media. One way of doing this is via **My Media**.



The My Media page displays.

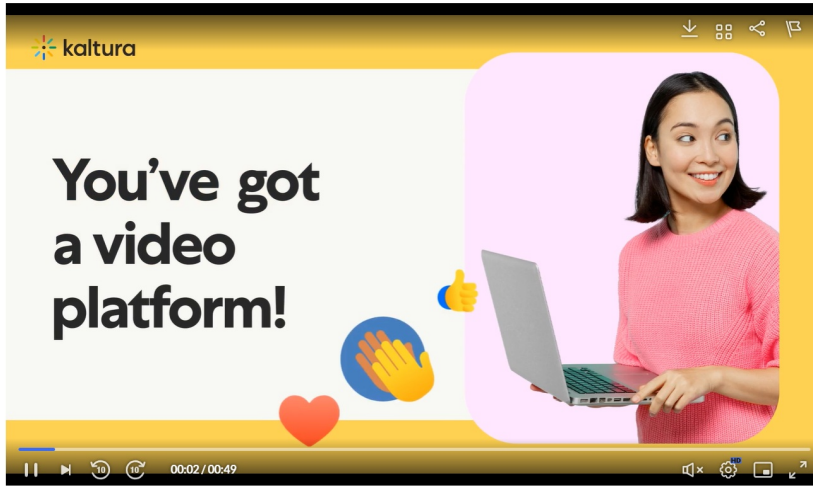
2. Locate the desired media and click the **pencil icon**.

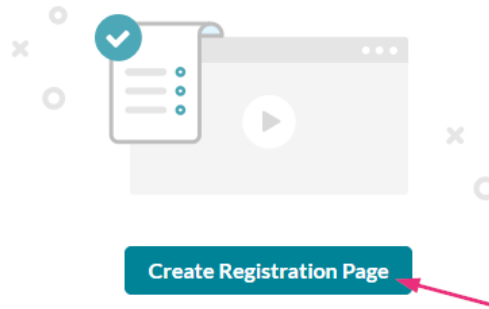


## 1. Click **Create Registration Page**.

### Add Registration Page To Your Media

Here you can create a registration page for your live event, VOD recording, or any video you'd like. This enables you to collect valuable information about your viewers that flows directly into your marketing database, CRM and more.

- **Email validation** - Upload or enter a closed list of emails and configure their permissions for the event.

Upload or enter a closed list of emails and configure their permissions for the event.

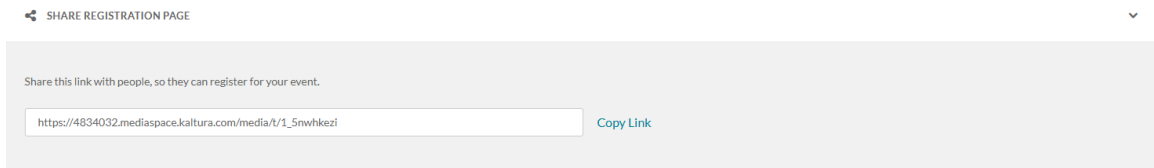

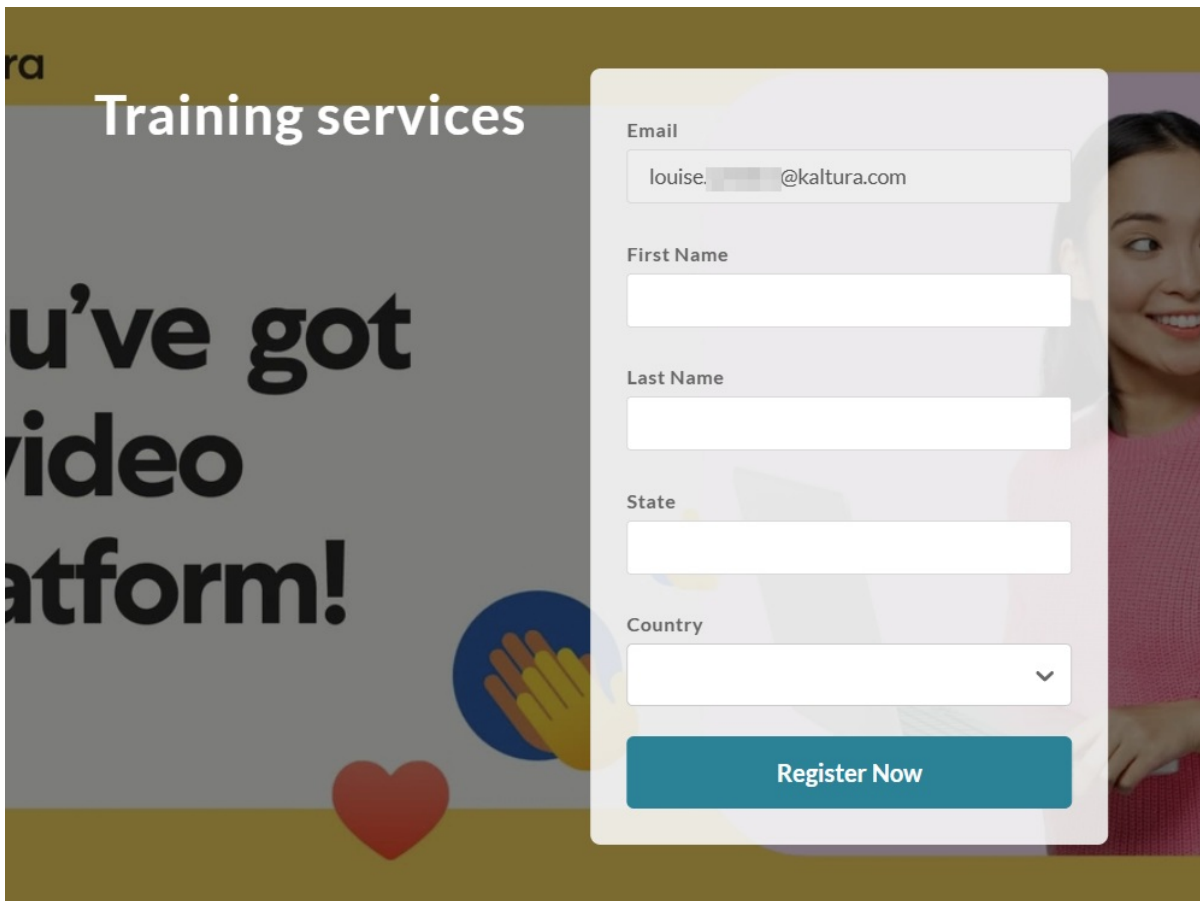
