2. Configure the following:

enabled - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

socialShare - Choose which social networks should be available in the share popup. This includes the "Copy a URL" option for sharing media. Choose from the following options:

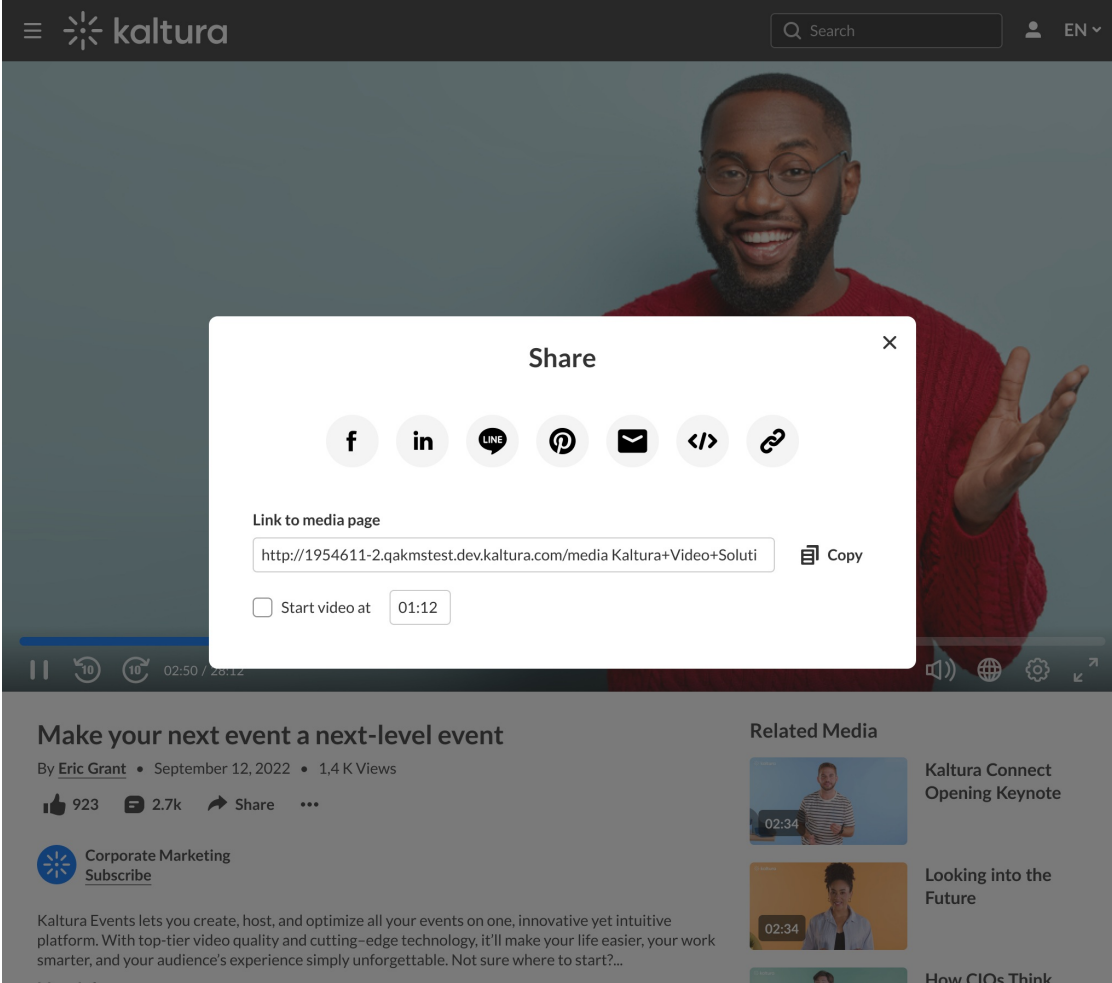
- Twitter ("X")

- Email
- URL

 If no social networks are selected, no embeds are available, and there's no content to display, the share button will not appear at all.

3. Click **Save**.
