## Configure the chat settings

### Add chat moderators

In the **Chat Moderators** field, start typing the names of the users you want to assign as moderators. Matching users will appear in the drop-down menu for you to select.

#### Chat moderators

Select users that are allowed to moderate the chat, reply to QnA, launch polls and interactions, and have access to the backchannel.
