

Create a video quiz assignment in Brightspace

About

This guide explains how to add a Kaltura Video Quiz to your Brightspace course so that student scores are automatically recorded in the gradebook.

There are two ways to add a Kaltura Video Quiz in Brightspace:

- **Add as a standalone activity** - This option adds the quiz as its own topic in a module using the **Add existing activities** option. The grade item is created automatically and you can adjust the points before students start.
- **Embed using 'Insert Stuff'** - This option lets you place the quiz inside a page, announcement, or anywhere there's a text editor with the **Insert Stuff** button. This is useful if you want to add extra instructions or context. The grade item is created automatically, but only after the first student submits the quiz.

Each method works well - choose the one that best fits where you want students to access the quiz and how you'd like it to appear in your course.



Remind students to complete their quiz in one sitting. If a quiz is left open for several hours or days, the browser session may expire and grades may not sync to the LMS gradebook. Encourage students to avoid long breaks or switching devices while taking the quiz.

Option 1: Add your assignment as a standalone activity

1. Create a video quiz. (See [Kaltura Video Quiz in Brightspace](#) to learn how.)
2. Go to your course.
3. Open the **Existing Activities** drop-down and select the Kaltura option (the exact name may vary, for example, 'Insert Media from Kaltura').

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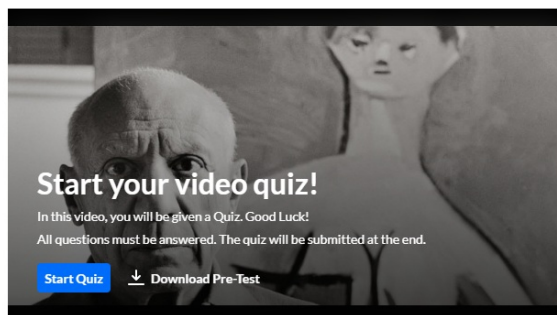




Option 2: Embed your quiz using 'Insert Stuff'

If you'd rather embed your quiz inside a page, announcement, or anywhere there's a text editor, you can use the **Insert Stuff** option. This is handy if you want to add instructions or extra context around the quiz.




When you use Insert Stuff, the grade item is created automatically after the first student submits the quiz.

1. Open any area in Brightspace that has a text editor, for example, click the **New** **drop-down** menu and select **Create a File**, or inside an announcement or assignment description.



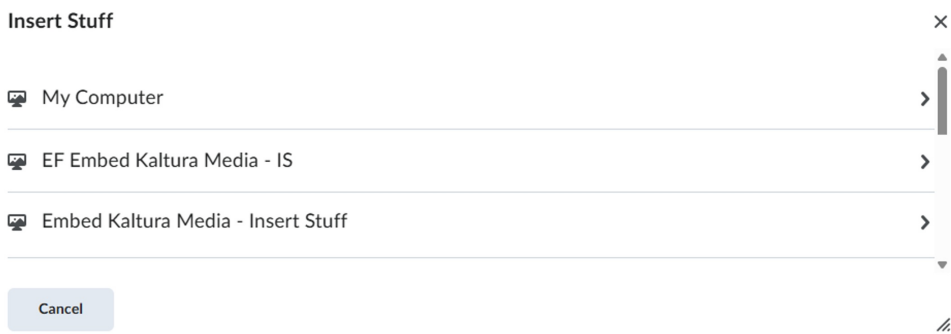


- Click **Insert**. The video is added to the editor.
